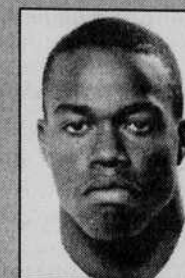

TONY GRAZIANI QUARTERBACK

Last season's starter went down in the game against Nevada with a pulled knee ligament. He began practicing last week and made the trip to Arizona State, but did not see action. He will be available to play if Ryan Perry-Smith gets injured against UCLA.



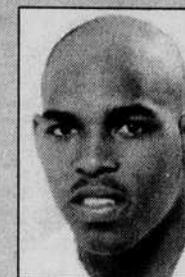
JERRY BROWN TAILBACK

The most recent of the Ducks' injuries, Brown broke his hand in Tuesday's practice. He will be sidelined for 4-6 weeks. He is currently Oregon's second leading rusher.



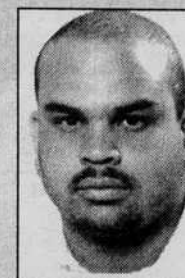
DAVID CRUMP TAILBACK

Listed as doubtful for the UCLA game with an injured shoulder, Crump has played in only three games this season. Despite this, he is the Ducks' third leading rusher.



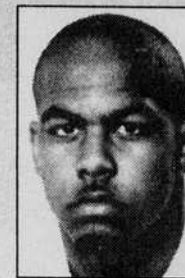
MICHAEL FLETCHER SAFETY

The redshirt freshman played in all five games this season, but went down late in the game against Arizona State with a knee injury. He is out for five weeks.



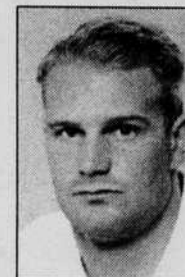
BRYANT JACKSON NOSE TACKLE

The junior is listed as questionable against UCLA with a left ankle injury sustained last week against the Arizona State Sun Devils.



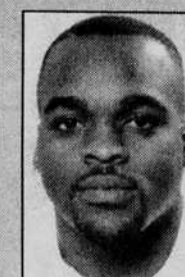
SALADIN MCCULLOUGH TAILBACK

Originally expected to be out for 5-8 weeks, Wilcox has recovered from a partially torn knee ligament in three weeks and is expected to play on Saturday.

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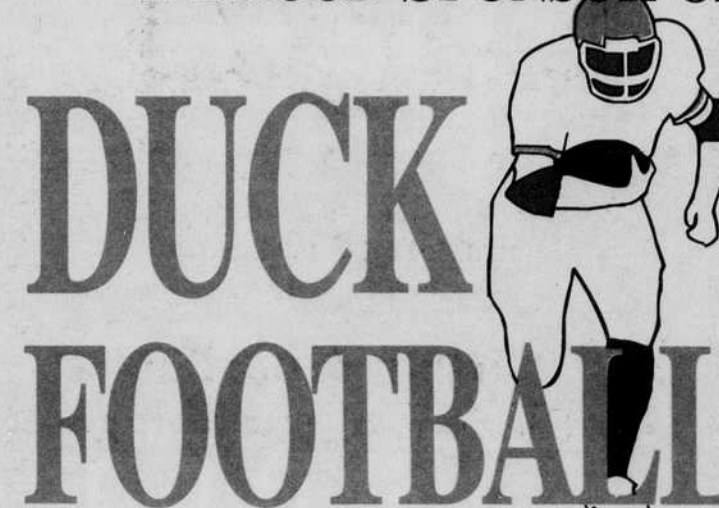
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
