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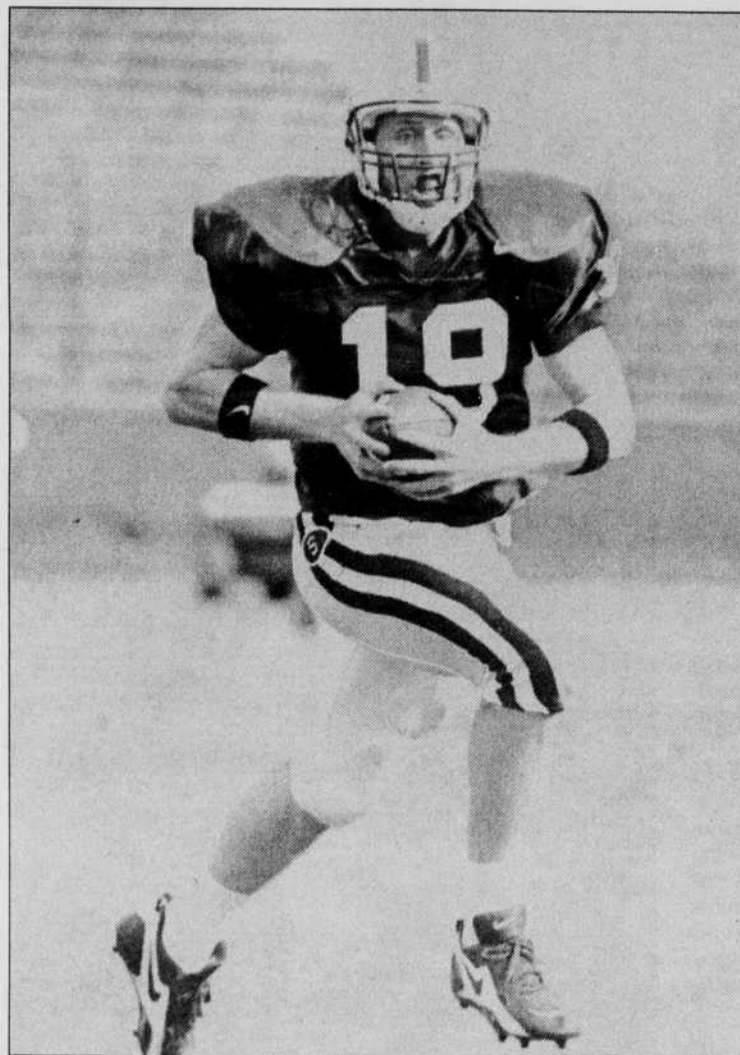
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Stanford: Mitchell carries rushing load



Stanford quarterback Chad Hutchinson threw for a season-high 365 yards while leading the Cardinal to a 27-24 overtime win.

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Stanford head coach Tyrone Willingham was pleased with his quarterback's performance.

"I believe he's getting better and better with each week, and we just want to keep going with him and let our team take off," Willingham said.

While Hutchinson got the job done for the Cardinal through the air, it was running back Mike Mitchell who pushed the Ducks back on the ground.

Mitchell scored two touchdowns for the Cardinal and finished the game with 121 yards rushing on 20 carries, including a 42-yard scamper for a score.

"Today I had to step up to help the team out," Mitchell said. "I was making good decisions on reading blocks and the offensive line was blocking well. If they don't give me the holes I can't run. They did a great job."

After carrying the ball 16 times in regulation, Mitchell took control of the game in overtime. After an Oregon turnover on its first possession of overtime, Mitchell carried on five consecutive plays to move the Cardinal in position for the game-winning field goal.

"Mike has really put together two good weeks for us," Willingham said. "We thought he did a real fine job up at Washington and came back today with some real good running, some real tough running."

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
