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EMU renovations presented to public

Preliminary designs of the EMU remodel were on display Monday for review by students, staff and other members of the University community.

Frank Geltner, associate director of the student union, said the proposed changes are meant to expand visibility and access to the EMU.

Spaces will be "opened up" to enlarge used space in the building and this will also give patrons greater perspective inside the building. And access will be increased via extra stairways leading into the building.

Another goal of the remodeling plan is to provide patrons with what they want from a student union.

Based on a market research analysis conducted last year, an EMU user-group found patrons have gotten bored with the variety of food available to them in the EMU. Proposed changes include

plans to replace Taco Time and Little Caesar's with a bakery, healthy food section, pasta and a deli.

The EMU may also be home to a marketplace booth. This booth would feature food vendors on a rotational basis. Food vendors who may be included in this rotation will be selling food Wednesday and Thursday from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. outside the EMU. Members of the remodel-planning committee will be collecting evaluations about the vendors based on what purchasers thought and will use this information in approaching vendors for year-long leases.

Construction on the EMU will begin in June after commencement and is scheduled to be completed by August of 1998.
