

Sosnow plays tough at tennis tourney

The Oregon men's and women's tennis teams spent the weekend at the Rolex Regional Tournament.

Dougal Williams advanced to the fourth round of singles play on the men's side. And in doubles play, three teams advanced to the second round. Williams and John DeVoss, Carlos Navarro and Mike Goldstein and Henry Oldham and Jeff Strong were all defeated in the second round of doubles play.

On the women's side, Allison Sosnow won both her first two matches before being eliminated with a third-round loss.

Both Oregon women's doubles teams advanced to the second round. Sosnow and Caryn Coyle and Shanelle Kaneshiro and Ali Napier picked up wins in the first round.

In singles play, both Kaneshiro and Coyle lost in the first round. While Napier advanced to the second round before losing.

Volleyball loses twice over the weekend

The Oregon volleyball team dropped two matches over the weekend to Stanford and California.

The Cardinal, ranked No. 2 in the country, swept the Ducks 15-8, 15-5, 15-3 on Friday night. Oregon was able to stay with Stanford in the first game and came within three points of the Cardinal in the second game. But Stanford was too strong and scored 22 of the next 25 points to take the match.

Madeline Ernst led the Ducks with eight kills and Alli White had seven. Tia Stewart had a career-high night with a .600 attack percentage in six kills and no errors.

On Saturday night, Oregon had a chance to beat California, a team that had been on a seven-match

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losing streak until the previous night when it beat Oregon State.

The Bears took the first game 15-10 and came back in the second game to get within 14-13 of the Ducks, but Oregon took the second game 15-13. The Ducks dropped the next two games 12-15 and 7-15 to lose the match.

White had 14 kills to lead Oregon and also had a team-high seven blocks. Amy Barnes had 12 kills, 17 digs and six blocks, and Michelle Christ contributed three service aces.

But California countered with five players in double figures for kills. Jessica Dinaberg had 18 kills and 28 digs.

The losses dropped the Ducks back into the Pacific-10 Conference cellar at 2-13 and 8-17 overall. They battle Portland on Wednesday night.

Slovan forfeits game to UO women's team

The Oregon women's basketball team had a more than interesting first exhibition game on Saturday against visiting Slovan Bratislava.

Leading the game 73-59, with four minutes and 41 seconds remaining, Slovan head coach Marian Matyas received a technical foul by referee Violet Palmer. The call made by Palmer sent Matyas into a rage along with club president Roman Adamcik, who stormed out of the stands yelling obscenities at Palmer. Palmer ordered for the two to be removed, however, prior to making the decision Adamcik instructed Matyas and his team to leave the court. The final result of the incident was the Ducks winning by forfeit.

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
