

# Library book sale today to raise funds for new books

As the holiday season approaches and students prepare for a break from the stress of classes and finals, it's time for them to start thinking about how to spend their time for the next few weeks.

For those who enjoy reading a good book or who are looking for



literary holiday gifts for friends and family, the University Library System's book sale offers an assortment of books.

"We have some really nice gifts," said Faye Chadwell, head of collection and development for the Knight Library. "Stuff we're not able to add [to the library's collection] because we already have it."

The library has been storing donated materials for the past few years, and now these items will be offered to the public to raise money to purchase new materials.

The items for sale will range in cost from \$1 to \$20 and will include subjects such as the humanities, romance languages, politics, art and architecture. There will also be some *Life* magazines from the 1940s and 1950s available.

The money made from the sale will be used toward purchasing books in areas such as the social sciences and Asian-American lit-

within the library.

The sale will be today in the Adelaide Church Memorial Browsing Room in the Knight Library from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and is open to the public.

Items that don't get sold may either be donated to other state higher education institutions, or book dealers might be called in to bid on the books, Chadwell said.
