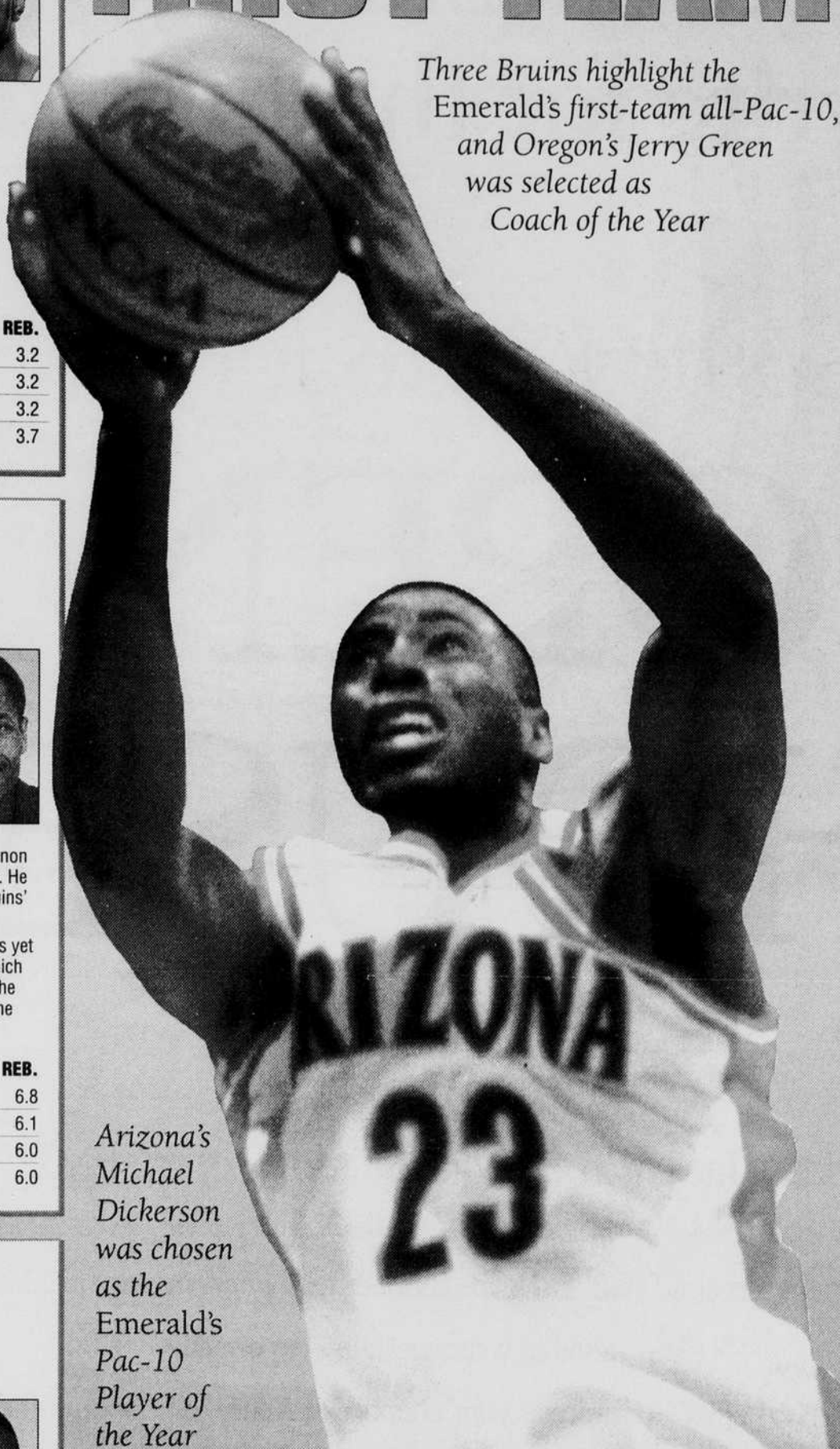


# PAC-10 MEN'S BASKETBALL FIRST TEAM



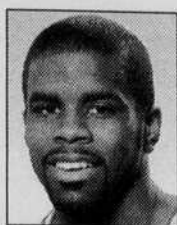
Arizona's Michael Dickerson was chosen as the Emerald's Pac-10 Player of the Year

## KENYA WILKINS

### OREGON

- NUMBER: 10
- HT: 5-11
- YEAR: Senior
- POSITION: Point guard



### ■ STRENGTHS:

Wilkins is arguably the quickest player in the Pac-10 and also one of the best ball handlers. Add to that his ability to score and he makes for the most potent point guard in the league. Wilkins also has a reputation for coming up big in big games.

- WEAKNESSES: Size.

Versatility and experience. O'Bannon can play both guard and forward. He will be looked upon to be the Bruins' main scorer.

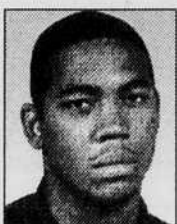

## JELANI MCCOY

### UCLA

- NUMBER: 34
- HT: 6-9
- YEAR: Sophomore
- POSITION: Center



### ■ STRENGTHS:

McCoy is the premier shot blocker in the league after averaging more than three per game last season as a freshman. He is very quick for his size and that makes him a good defender as well.

- WEAKNESSES: McCoy doesn't look to score that much despite having one of the best field-goal percentages in the league last year.

## TOBY BAILEY

### UCLA

### ■ STRENGTHS:

Bailey is one of the best outside shooters in the league as he hovered around 40 percent from beyond the arch last season. He is also tall for a guard, which makes him a strong defender and a good rebounder.

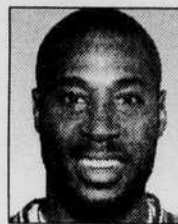
- WEAKNESSES: Inconsistency is Bailey's main weakness, which causes him to be less than spectacular in the second half.

## MICHAEL DICKERSON

### ARIZONA

- NUMBER: 23
- HT: 6-5
- YEAR: Junior
- POSITION: Forward



### ■ STRENGTHS:

There isn't much that Dickerson can't do, and he has proven it this season. With most of Arizona's top scorers gone this season, he has stepped up his game, averaging 10 points per game more than last year. He can also shoot from anywhere.

- WEAKNESSES: This season, like last season, Dickerson has suffered bouts of inconsistency.

## COACH JERRY GREEN

### OREGON

- YEAR: 5th
- In his 14th season as a head coach and his fifth at the helm of Oregon, Jerry Green has his Ducks



playing at the top of their game with a 10-0 start. In 17 years of college coaching experience as a head coach at North Carolina-Asheville, and also as an assistant at Kansas, Green has 318 wins against 197 losses. Green is 65-59 at Oregon and took the Ducks to their first NCAA tournament in 24 years in just his third season.
