Crowd, point guards highlight contest

Stanford's head coach is prepared for key match-up this weekend

Coming to Eugene to face the Oregon men's basketball team poses two specific challenges for any team: playing against one of the league's best point guards in Kenya Wilkins and playing in one of the nation's most imposing arenas — McArthur Court.

Even if you are the 15th-ranked Stanford Cardinal. "It has always been tough to play in Eugene," Stanford head coach Mike Montgomery said. "It has always been one of the tougher places to play in the conference."

"Typically, the problem winning on someone else's home court has more to do with the team being good. But of all places, because of the structure and where the people are, [McArthur Court] makes it a little more difficult. The court seems to get a little bit smaller when things get towards the end of the game. Plus [the Ducks] have the crowd helping them along."

The 24th-ranked Ducks will take on the Cardinal Thursday night at The Pit, the first time since 1995 that Oregon has hosted a matchup of two nationally ranked teams. Plus, the fact that Oregon has not played at home in over a month should make this game a little more raucous. Add into the mix that Oregon is coming off of its first two losses of the season and maybe wanting a win a little bit more.

"I think everybody is hungry at home," Montgomery said. "Winning on the road is going to be very difficult. So the sense of urgency might be heightened to win at home because all of us understand the importance."

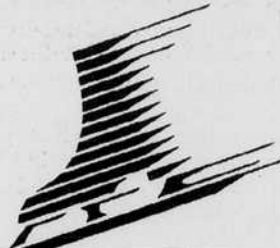
