ORTOVOX AVALANCHE TRANSCIEVERS

One component of the Allard and Casey Memorial Safety Library is Ortovox Avalanche Transceivers. In a full burial wilderness avalanche incident, only immediate and effective search and rescue by companions offers real chance of survival. An avalanche beacon used properly can be a powerful tool for recovery. This clinic will cover the basics of avalanche rescue procedures, including hands-on use of the library transceivers. Remember, carry avalanche transceivers to lower your risk profile, not as an excuse to take risks! Free!
