

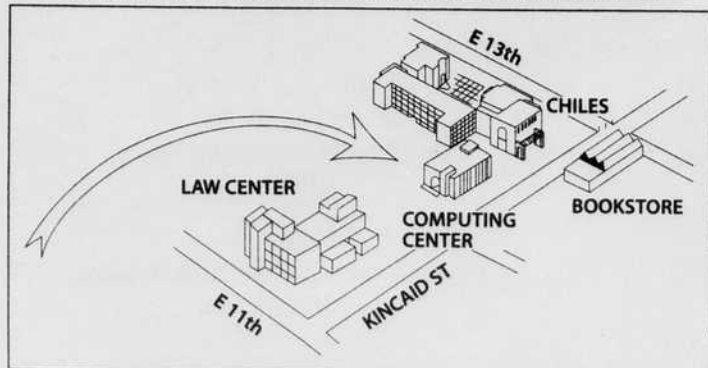

Force of Star Wars draws crowds

■ ANALYSIS: Enthusiastic swarms of college students flock to the theater to see the classic film of their youth

Crowds gathered en masse Thursday morning outside ticket offices on both sides of town to get opening-day seats to perhaps the only movie that could still sell out audiences 20 years after it was first released.

"Star Wars" originally came out in 1977, before many students were old enough to see it on the big screen. Friday was their chance to see the biggest movie of their youth on a theater screen for the first time, now with new footage and improved visual and audio effects.

"I feel 'Star Wars' is the defining moment of our generation, and seeing it again on the big screen is probably the second greatest moment of my life," said student Pete Burns.

The term "fan," stemming, of course, from fanatic, was given new meaning when the movie sold out in 15 minutes at Movieland theaters.

The 10:20 p.m. showing Friday night had a crowd consisting mainly of college students who were, to say the least, excited to be given a chance to see the premiere re-showing of the first movie in a much-loved trilogy.

"We went to the late show, and it was a good atmosphere because it was a 20 to 30-year-old age group, and everyone was just there to have a good time. A lot of us when we were kids didn't

get to see it in the theaters, and this was the way it should have been," said student Andy Klink.

Neither rain nor cold weather could prevent potential viewers from feeling the force of such a colossal movie. Gratitude for the re-release was obvious when the viewers responded with loud cheers of celebration when the traditional music began to play, signaling the start of the age-old battle between good and evil.

There were hints of discontent after the initial excitement had worn off, however. People questioned if Lucas' intentions were financial and suggested the new scenes were largely ineffective despite attention they had received from the media.

"The slap-stick humor they put in the new scenes pulled the viewer out of the movie and did-

n't follow the mood of the traditional 'Star Wars,'" said student Gary Lodge.

With every big event, there will be those in its midst who fail to be overpowered by the enthusiasm and vocally display their skepticism. The overall take on the film, however, was positive, and many felt it gave young adults a chance to be children again, while cheering for their heroes.

Whether "Star Wars" had new profound supplements or whether Lucas re-released it for a few bucks is really insignificant next to the power of the force — the force that drives people to the theaters at the crack of dawn to ensure a seat, the force that draws cheers of acceptance at the opening credits and the force of nostalgia that carries viewers off their feet again, if just for a few hours.
