Campus restaurant has relaxed atmosphere

Located near campus, the Glenwood offers tasty food and provides a good study environment

The Glenwood is best described as a campus coffee shop. You won't find many retired couples there for the early bird special, nor will you find large families enjoying Sunday brunch in their church clothes.

At this place, you are more likely to find groups of students studying or just hanging out with friends. With business hours that extend late into the night, it is no wonder that the Glenwood has become a tradition around here for many students.

The Glenwood serves up a variety of breakfast and brunch items all day, with lunch and dinner served after 10:30 a.m.

The Scrambles — eggs cooked with vegetable and meat choices — are popular. A simple favorite, Say Cheese, is eggs scrambled with cheese and served with potatoes or fruit and your choice of

bread for \$3.60.

For lunch and dinner, you can choose from an assortment of sandwiches and burgers served with your choice of soup, salad, potatoes, fruit or cottage cheese for \$2.95-\$5.95.

Entrées range from Chicken or Tofu Yakisoba to burrito and pasta dishes served with soup or salad for \$3.95-\$6.95.

A good deal for lighter appetites is the Bowl & Muffin, a bowl of tomato cheese soup or the soup of the day served with a muffin, croissant or bagel for \$3.25.

The menu offers many vegetarian choices, and several items are available with vegetarian substitutes.

The Glenwood has a relaxed atmosphere that is fine for having a leisurely meal or a study session with friends, but don't expect to go there for a quick bite to eat. Although friendly, the service is often slow. The Glenwood often seems to be chronically understaffed during

busy times. Don't be surprised if your server seems to disappear into thin air after he or she brings you your food. At least you can count on nobody bothering you while you are studying.
