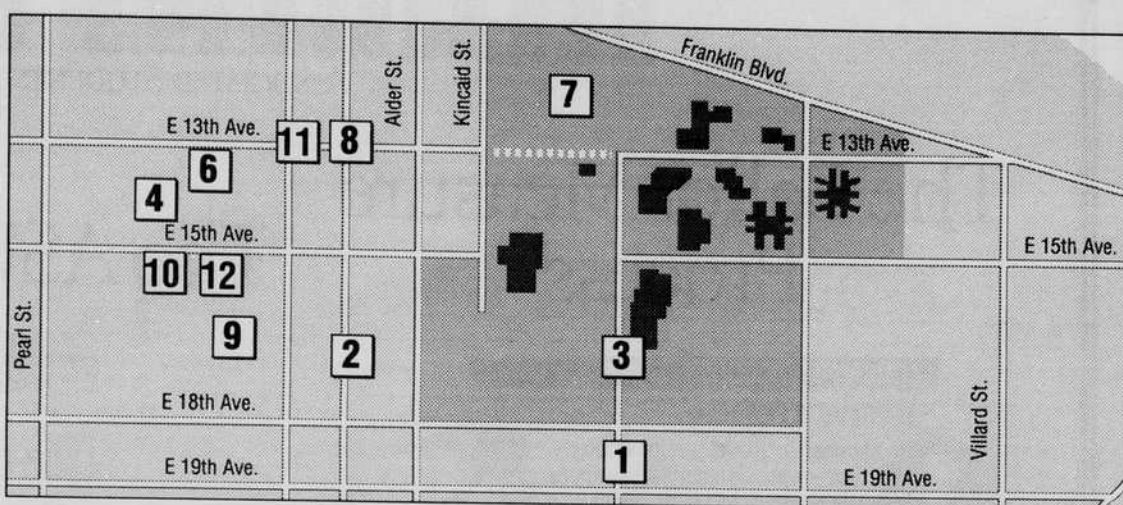

POLICE BEAT

Assault charge filed

1 A University student was charged with Sexual Assault III on Feb. 6. He was attending a party on Feb. 2 at an apartment south of the University, and according to police reports, he made unwanted sexual advances on an LCC student who was also attending the party. A member of the party told police that the suspect had consumed a full bottle of brandy that night and was believed to be intoxicated.

Pizza driver robbed

2 According to police reports, a Domino's Pizza delivery person was robbed at knife-point at 10:48 p.m. on the driveway of 1158 Mill St. while making a delivery. According to police reports, the suspect approached the victim's car after the delivery was made and tapped on his driver's side window. When the victim unrolled the window, the suspect "stuck a knife in his face" and said, "Give me your money. All of it." After taking the victim's money, the suspect ran east towards an apartment complex.

Suspects steal soda

3 A pedestrian was robbed of his Minute Maid soda by three suspects on East 17th Avenue and Hilyard Street at approximately 9:15 p.m. on Feb. 10. One of the three suspects was armed with a semi-automatic handgun and, according to police reports, said, "Give me your pop." Once the victim gave them his drink, the suspects ran towards Patterson Street.

Caller attracts police

4 A male living on East 14th Avenue was charged with furnishing alcohol to minors on Feb. 7 at approximately 11 p.m. Police arrived at the man's apartment because a girl in the apartment called her mother, "confused about where she was," and her mother used caller identification to find out the location. Her mother then called the police and requested that they investigate. Officers found four people present, including the girl who had called her mother. One individual present was already wanted on previous charges of Theft I and contempt of court. The fourth individual was charged with minor in possession.

Drugs found on minor

6 A thirteen-year-old male was charged with three counts of unlawful delivery of controlled substances (UDCS) and one count of unlawful possession of a controlled substance when an EPD officer stopped him on 13th Avenue and found in his possession two bags of marijuana and two bags of psilocybin mushrooms, stated police reports. Sgt. Poppe of EPD said the male had a history of selling marijuana, and officers were asked by his mother to "keep an eye on his welfare."

Bikes stolen from UO

7 Nine bikes were stolen from the campus area within the last week and the total financial value of all the bikes was estimated to be about \$3500, including a Cannondale worth approximately

\$1800, said Sgt. Poppe.

Shoplifter arrested

8 An individual was charged with Shoplifting II after he attempted to steal a pair of sunglasses from the University Bookstore, according to police reports.

Frat stereo stolen

9 Stereo equipment was stolen during a fraternity party on Feb. 7 at around 2:30 a.m. The party consisted of approximately 150+ people, and no arrests were made.

Car found damaged

10 Damage was done to a Volkswagen Jetta on the 600 block of E. 15th on Feb. 8 during what police reports describe as an "MIP party." The damage to the car is estimated to be around \$2500, and no arrests were made.

Skateboarder stopped

11 A male was stopped on East 13th Avenue at around 1:45 p.m. for violating a skateboard ordinance and was found to have a warrant out for a previous consumption on unlicensed premises.

Keg seized from party

12 A keg was seized from a house on East 15th Avenue on Feb. 9 because there was no one of age at the party and no one was identified as having bought the keg, according to police reports.

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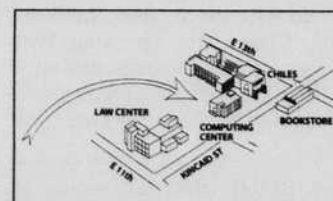
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
