

## Oregon Queer Film Festival to start soon

The 5th Annual University of Oregon Queer Film Festival will take place this weekend and next weekend. The festival, sponsored by the Student Activities Resource Office and the Lesbian Gay Bisexual Transgender Alliance, will feature a number of premier and award-winning films, videos and documentaries. All of the events will take place in 180 PLC.

The festival will kick off on Saturday with Eugene's premier showings of the feature film "Stonewall" at 7:30 and 9:30 p.m.

The festival will end with the documentary "It's Elementary," by Academy Award-winning director and filmmaker Debra Chasnof at 7:30 on Sunday, Feb. 23. Chasnof won an Academy Award for a film exposé about General Electric toxic dumpings performed by Chasnof — the first woman to ever publicly thank her partner during an Academy Awards ceremony speech.

Tickets are available at the EMU Ticket Office, Hungry Head Books and Mother Kali's Books. The prices are \$4 for University students and \$5 for the general public.
