

Forum: Oregon's Solicitor General to deliver keynote speech

Reflections on the Road Behind and the Road Ahead," said although in nearly 17 years of her practice women have become more prominent and accepted in the legal profession, she is not ready for a decline in emphasis on the issue. "We are not at a point where this issue can stop being talked about," she said.

Discussion panels will also be held throughout the day to give students and community members a chance to ask questions and discuss current women's le-

gal issues. Topics such as domestic violence and animal abuse, between which conference co-director April Campbell said show a direct correlation, will be discussed.

Also scheduled for the panels are topics such as gun control legislation relating to domestic violence, reproductive rights and gay and lesbian parenting and adoptions.

Campbell said she hopes the panels will give people a chance "to learn about new fields in law that they weren't aware of. I also

hope this will help people to open their eyes about how legal issues affect women differently than men."

The conference will conclude with a reunion of University women law students hosted by Law professor Caroline Forell. There will be entertainment by the feminist improvisational comedy group Wymprov in the EMU Fountain Court at 7 p.m.

Campbell expects the conference to be well attended this year, with more response from legal

professionals in the community.

"This is the first year we have offered continuing legal education credit for free for the conference," Campbell said. "People seem to be more receptive because of this."

Linder says she is looking forward to the opportunity to speak at the conference. "It all gets overwhelming — it's been a nice roadside rest to think about what has happened, and look forward. The future holds unforeseen twists and turns."

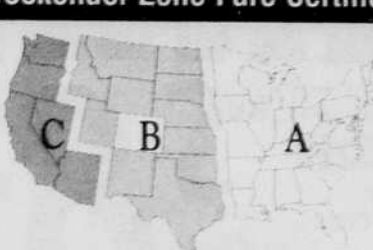
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
