

PFC grants increases for two groups

■ **FUNDING:** The Asian Pacific American Law Students Association received \$300 for their new group

The Programs Finance Committee met last night to discuss the 1997-98 budget requests for ASUO Child Care and Development Centers, and the Asian Pacific American Law Students Association.

The ASUO CCDC requested an increase of .6 percent to provide child care subsidies for 220 families instead of the 200 families that are currently being served. ASUO Finance Coordinator Kent Black recommended that CCDC's budget be funded as requested.

funded CCDC's budget request at \$232,451, a .6 percent increase from this year.

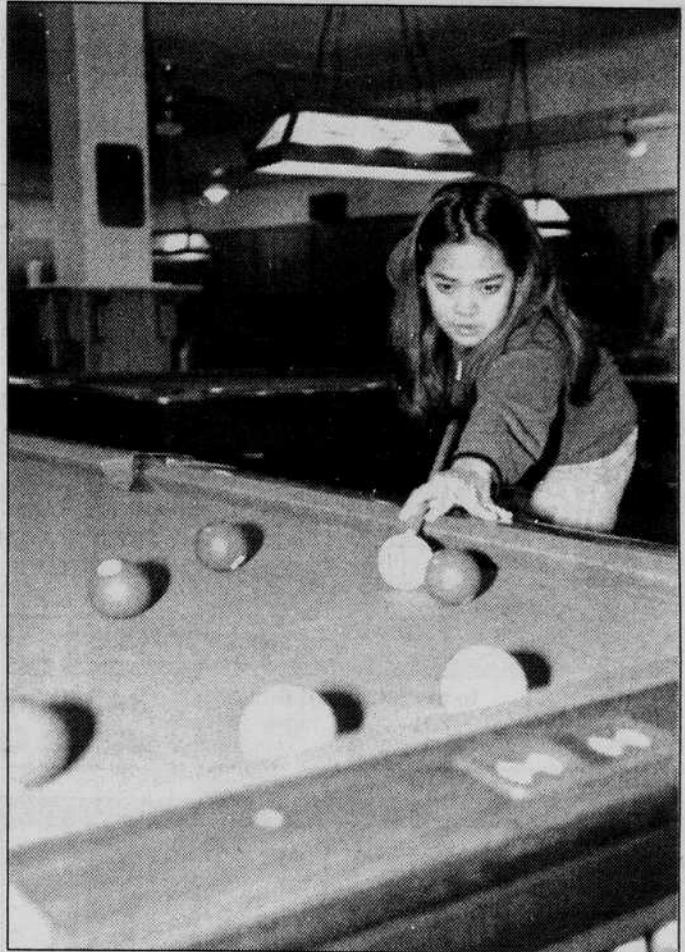

The PFC amended the travel, events and speakers line items without decreasing the groups request. APALS' budget request of \$300 was approved.
