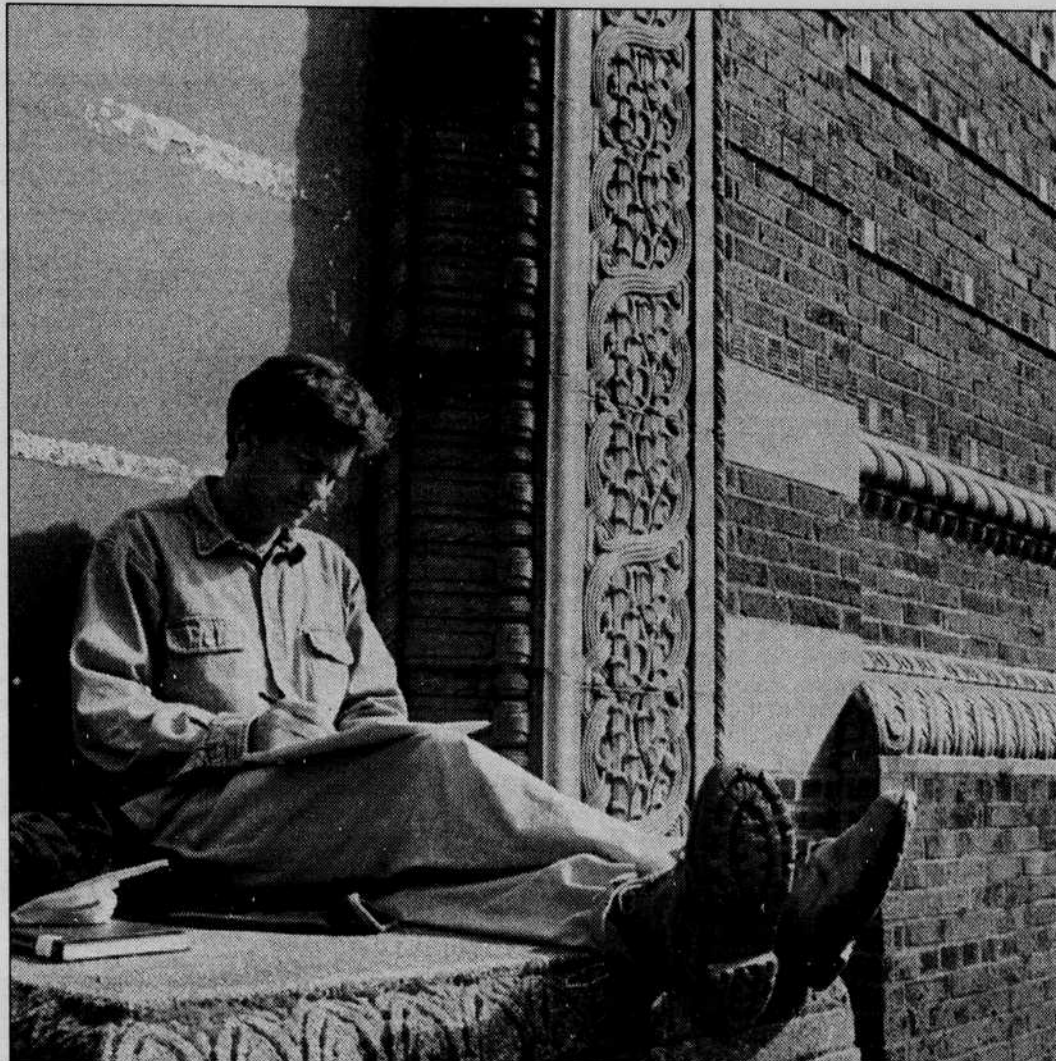


Studying in the sun
