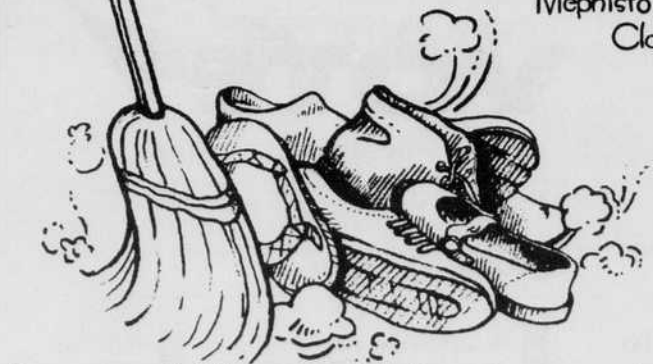

POLICE BEAT

2,900 Emeralds stolen

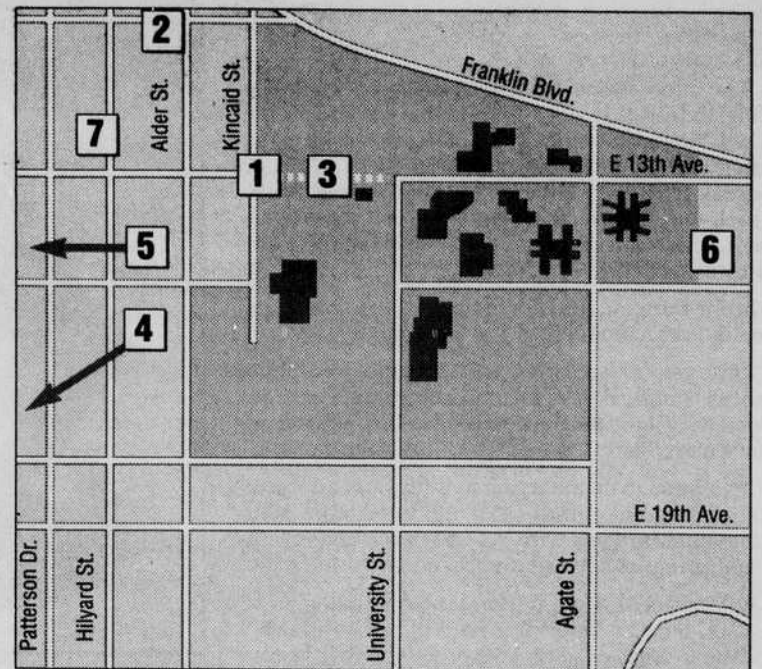
1 The distributor of the *Oregon Daily Emerald* reported to police that 29 bundles of Tuesday's paper were stolen from the distribution point at the University Bookstore shortly after delivery around 7 a.m. Tuesday morning, said Judy Riedl, the general manager at ODE. When the individual responsible for distributing the papers around campus arrived to pick them up, he told police he saw two males in a white car, with what he believed to be Fiji bumper stickers next to the license plate, loading the papers into the car. There was another car involved, but no description was available. The value of the stolen property was estimated to be \$1,846.15. The *Emerald* is taking the incident seriously and is willing to pursue and press charges against whomever is responsible.

Police get fight call

2 A party at the Sigma Nu fraternity house on Friday night and into Saturday morning resulted in one arrest for littering and minor in possession and a police response to a fight call, police reports stated. The first incident involved a Clackamas Community College student who was observed by police to have walked out of the party with a can of beer which he discarded into the street at approximately 12:30 a.m. on Saturday morning. He was approached by police and after a brief investigation was charged with MIP and littering. The fight was between members of Sigma Nu and Phi Kappa Psi and occurred at approximately 11:50 p.m. Members of Mohawk Valley Security, who were hired to control the party, called Eugene police for assistance in handling the fight. By the time the officers arrived, however, the fight was broken up and the members of Phi Kappa Psi had vacated the premises. No arrests were made regarding the incident and police have no leads as to the identity of the Phi Kappa Psi members.

Police find fake ID

3 A University student was charged with possession of a forged instrument on April 13 at 10:30 p.m. when officers from the



Eugene police department observed him driving down the section of 13th Avenue that is closed vehicular traffic. During an investigation the officer from Eugene police noticed the driver had an identification in his possession other than his own. The student told police he used the identification to buy alcohol at local stores and attend concerts that allow only people over the age of 21. He was cited and released.

Officer harassed

4 A party at 3541 Willamette St. at 12:13 a.m. on April 12 resulted in several citations including a harassment charge that was issued to a student who, according to police, pushed an officer in the chest to prevent him from taking his cup of beer. The suspect was charged with harassment and minor in possession and taken outside and handcuffed until the party could be cleared. The host was charged with a noise violation and one other member was charged with minor in possession and consumption on unlicensed premises. All of those charged were released on the scene.

Noisy party busted

5 Another party was broken up at approximately 12:07 a.m. at 1359 Mill St. on April 13 in which the host was cited for a noise violation and two other individuals were cited with minor

in possession. According to police reports, officers were responding to a loud party complaint and found an undetermined number of people both in the house and in the backyard. After an investigation the host was instructed to clear the party. All of the subjects charged were released at the scene.

Compact discs stolen

6 A portable compact disc player, 50 compact discs and a pair of sunglasses were stolen from a University student's Honda Civic sometime between April 7 and April 11 while it was parked at E. 15th Avenue and Moss Street, police reports stated. The method of entry is unknown, but the driver's side door was found unlocked. Eugene police are calling it a Theft 1 and have no leads at this time.

Transient arrested

7 A 34-year-old transient was cited for having an open container while in the alley between 12th Avenue and 13th Avenue at approximately 4:51 p.m. on April 11. Police were responding to a complaint about the suspect being drunk and disorderly. He was taken into custody without incident but once in the back of the patrol car, he began slamming his upper body against the door of the car.
