Police catch thief

Several reportedly stolen checks cashed at area banks were found to be the result of apparent thefts from the Knight Library. Police traced the identity of the individual who cashed the checks and displayed his picture inside the library. On April 16 at 4:07 p.m. a man who fit the description was seen by an employee of the library who then called the police. Officer Mozan of the Eugene police department arrived to investigate and identified the man as being the suspect in question, police reports said. Upon investigation the man was found to have property in his possession that had been reported stolen, and he was charged with Forgery II, theft and fraudulent use of a credit card.

Man flashes students

A University student and her friend reported to Eugene police that upon arriving at the parking lot of Gamma Phi Beta sorority house, they were approached at 2:20 a.m. on April 19 by an unidentified male who was expos-

ing himself beside their car, police said. He began making suggestive remarks and the two women fled into the house and called the police. Officers responded but had no luck in locating the suspect.

Fraternity damaged

A suspended member of Sigma Nu fraternity was arrested at 2:30 a.m. on April 18 when he entered the house of Sigma Nu and began causing damage to its interior, police reports stated. He entered the house on 18th Avenue and broke several windows, knocked over tables, and caused damage to the president of Sigma Nu's room. When Eugene police officers arrived, the suspect was detained by members of the fraternity. He was charged with criminal mischief II and taken to LCAC.

Police find transient

In a routine check of Gilbert Hall at 10:28 p.m. on April 19, Sgt. Luna of the Eugene police department found a 42-year-old transient in room 111 with chairs stacked up against the inside of the door, police reports said. Once inside, Sgt. Luna found the tran-

sient sleeping on the floor in the room. Luna asked for identification and the suspect said he did not have any. The suspect then tried to leave by pushing Sgt. Luna out of the way but was stopped and put into handcuffs. The suspect was charged with criminal trespassing and harassment and was lodged at LCAC.

Student trespasses

A University student who had been banned from the housing facility was cited for trespassing when he was seen in the Hamilton dining hall on April 18 at 7 p.m. by a resident assistant. The RA called OPS and officers arrived to investigate the situation. At the urging of the resident director, the student was charged with trespassing.

Men harass clerk

A clerk from Tom's Market at 1490 E. 19th Ave. reported to police that on April 20 two subjects entered the store at 1:20 a.m. One of them attempted to buy beer, but the clerk felt the identification was fraudulent so he secured it in a lock box. The subject became ver-

bally aggressive and the clerk escorted him out by the ear. Later in the evening the subject returned with a wooden baseball bat and demanded to purchase a pack of cigarettes. The clerk told the suspect to leave the store. The suspect then swung the bat and struck the clerk in the left forearm. The suspect's car has been identified and an investigation is underway.

Thief steals backpack

A backpack containing \$459 worth of belongings was stolen from room 185 of McArthur Court Student Services building on April 15 between 2:15 p.m. and 2:25 p.m. No suspect information is known at this time.

Thief robs car, garage

The resident on Harris St. reported to Eugene police that on April 20 between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. \$1,173 worth of belongings were stolen from his pick-up truck and garage. One of the items stolen from the garage was a bicycle, which was replaced at the scene with a different bicycle. Police do not know the purpose of this.
