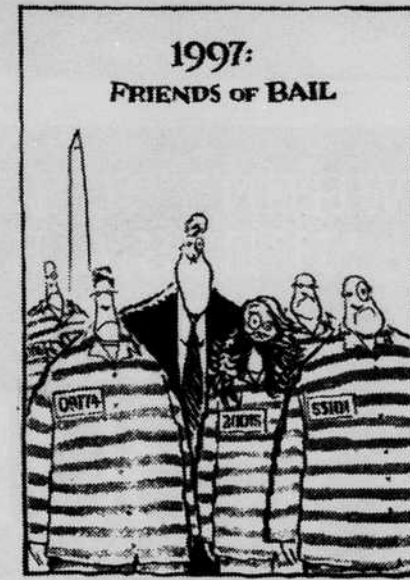
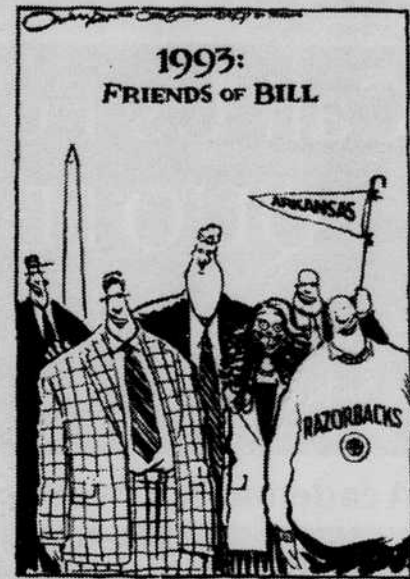

Get the most out of your mountain bike this spring! Your bike takes a lot of abuse out on the trails, over the rivers and through the woods. Your components require regular maintenance to keep everything working smoothly. Come to Collin's Cycle Shop for a night of mechanical instruction from the pros. ### Whitewater Rescue Clinic

If you run rivers, you will encounter situations that require competent rescue skills. Care enough about the people you boat with to know how to rescue them and yourself. This clinic is a major step up from our traditional one day, land-based course. Guy Santiago, owner of Oregon River Sports and noted river rescue instructor, will teach a river-based, weekend rescue seminar. Useful knots, rope systems, hardware, swimming techniques, and rescue strategies will be covered in this hands-on clinic. \$125 for students and co-op members; \$150 for general public...this is a killer price.
