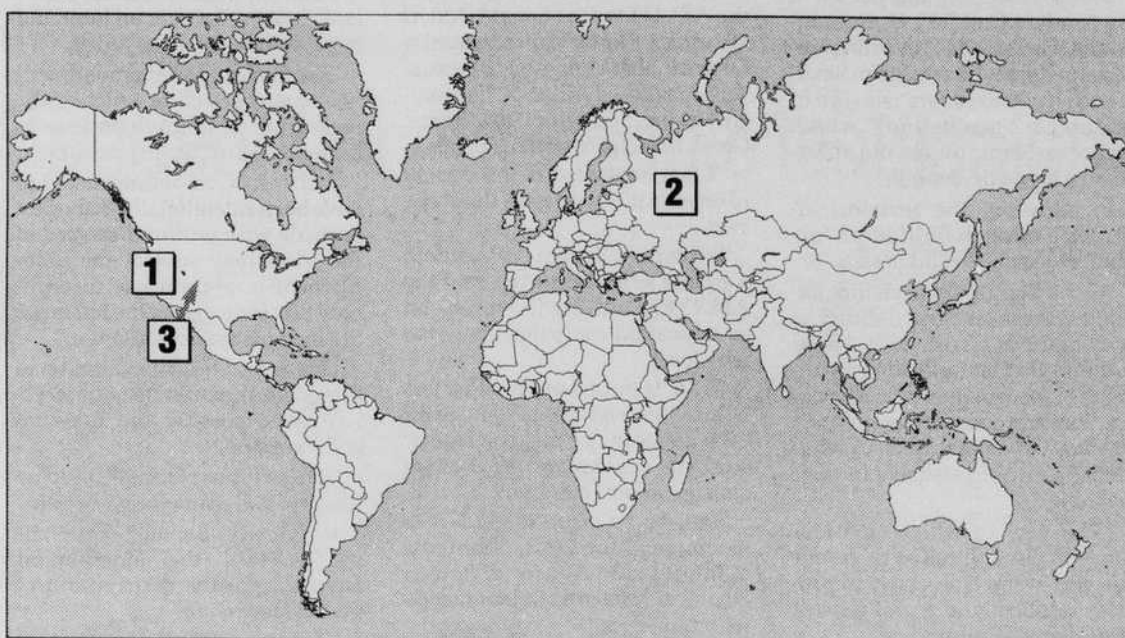

Moore: Final days of a death row inmate?

1 SALEM — As his execution date nears, convicted killer Harry Charles Moore has been cheerful and upbeat, watching cop shows on TV and cracking jokes, prison officials said Wednesday.

Moore, convicted in the 1992 shooting deaths of his in-laws, is scheduled to die by lethal injection at 12:01 a.m. Friday at the Oregon State Penitentiary.

Moore, 56, has refused to appeal his death sentence. Unless he changes his mind at the last minute, he will become only the second person in Oregon to be executed since 1962.

NATO, Russia reach landmark agreement

2 MOSCOW — NATO and Russia entered a new era of guarded cooperation Wednesday, agreeing on a landmark accord outlining post-Cold War security and designed to assuage Moscow's anger over the alliance's expansion.

The former foes praised the agreement as a big stride toward ensuring a peaceful Europe. President Clinton said it would give Russia a "voice in, but not a veto over NATO's business."

The document, if approved by the 16 member nations, could be signed May 27 when Yeltsin travels to Paris for a Russia-NATO summit.

Camera links Ryder truck to bombing

3 DENVER — Jurors saw chilling surveillance pictures Wednesday of a Ryder truck moving toward the Oklahoma City federal building minutes before a bomb exploded.

One by one, the stills flashed on a courtroom monitor, showing the street through the glass of the Regency Towers apartment complex a block from the federal building. The truck appears in the background of the frame, the word "Ryder" clearly visible.

On April 19, 1995, a truck bomb exploded outside the Alfred P. Murrah federal building, killing 168 people and injuring more than 500.
