Student Senate OKs fund transfer

■ **FUNDS:** If given more specifics, the Senate may also fund the expansion of a playing field on campus

The Student Senate approved a transfer of funds for the Co-op Family Center and recommended that the Campus Recreation facilities return for a special request when it had more specifics on its project Wednesday.

The Co-op Family Center requested that \$15,000 be transferred from its work study line item to payroll. The Center was unable to find enough work study students and needed the funds to pay for student workers without work study.

The request was unanimously approved by the Senate.

The Campus Recreation Facilities requested \$40,000 from surplus in order to expand the playing field on the South Bank, next to the Research Center.



Sandy Vaughn, director for Club Sports, said this expansion is necessary because two fields currently used for practice will be gone due to the construction of the new law school and the expansion of the recreation center.

The Senate was concerned, however, that there are no specific plans for the playing field and that the research center has not approved the expansion.

Vaughn said it would be easier to get approval if there were some funds already appropriated for

the project.

Currently, the fields are used for Club Sports and Recreation and Intermural sports activities. More than 1,000 students per year participate in these programs. Both programs are funded solely by the students.

The Senate recommended that the program get an estimate of how much it would cost to have an architect to survey the field and draw up plans then return to the Senate for funding approval. The Senate felt the plans were too unsure at this point. Also, if money had been allocated, it would have to be spent by July 1. Otherwise, it rolls over into next year's account.

Senator David McGee reported that five computers purchased by the Senate did not function and had to be shipped back.

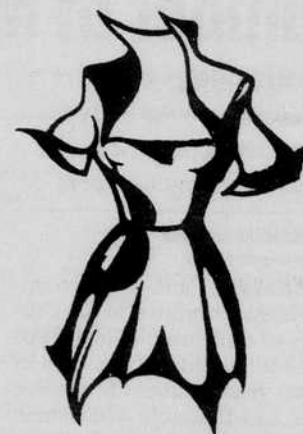
