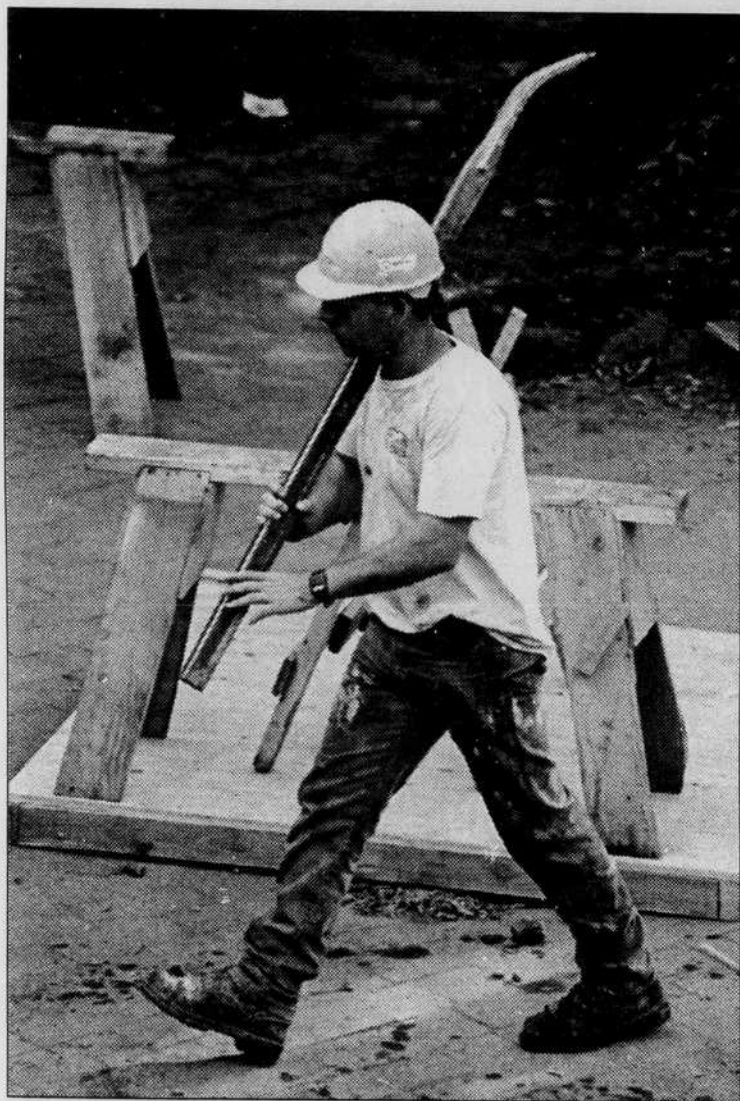


EMU CONSTRUCTION



In case you haven't noticed, Phase One of the EMU renovation has officially begun. Chain link fences completely surround the courtyard and the main entrance to the building has been boarded over.
