## Drinking: Activities offer alternative to alcohol

"We are trying to promote alternatives to drinking," Dochnahl said. "A lot of students claim there is nothing to do around campus but drink, so we're putting on a Fun Run today."

The 5K Fun Run is billed as an event to "show drinking and driving sucks." The run begins today at 4 p.m. on the east lawn of the EMU. Everyone who participates is eligible for prize drawings, plus refreshments.

Immediately following the run will be a free concert open to the public on the EMU East Lawn by local band Jacob Marley's Ghost from 5 to 8 p.m.

GAMMA is also working independently to promote its philosophy around the University this week.

"We're doing a windshield wash on cars parked around campus," GAMMA co-chairperson Stacie Doran said. "After we wash their windshields, we will be putting a flier on their car saying we have done something for you, so you can do something for us by not drinking and driving."

GAMMA is also working on

other projects unrelated to Alcohol Awareness Week. One idea the group has is for members to place mock parking tickets on cars that include blood-alcohol charts showing how much alcohol must be consumed to produce a specific blood-alcohol level, as well as the phone numbers for Saferide and taxi services.

"It's very important that this message hits home," Doran said. "Students tend to have an immortality complex, but they need to realize that they're not immortal."

That's why the Grim Reaper project is so effective. It shows people our age who have died as a result of drinking and driving. People need to realize alcohol requires responsibility, and it affects everyone around you."

Students who believe they, or someone they know or care about, may have a drinking problem can contact the health center, the University counseling office, the University crisis line or a local chapter of Alcoholics Anonymous. All will provide anonymous counseling and support.
