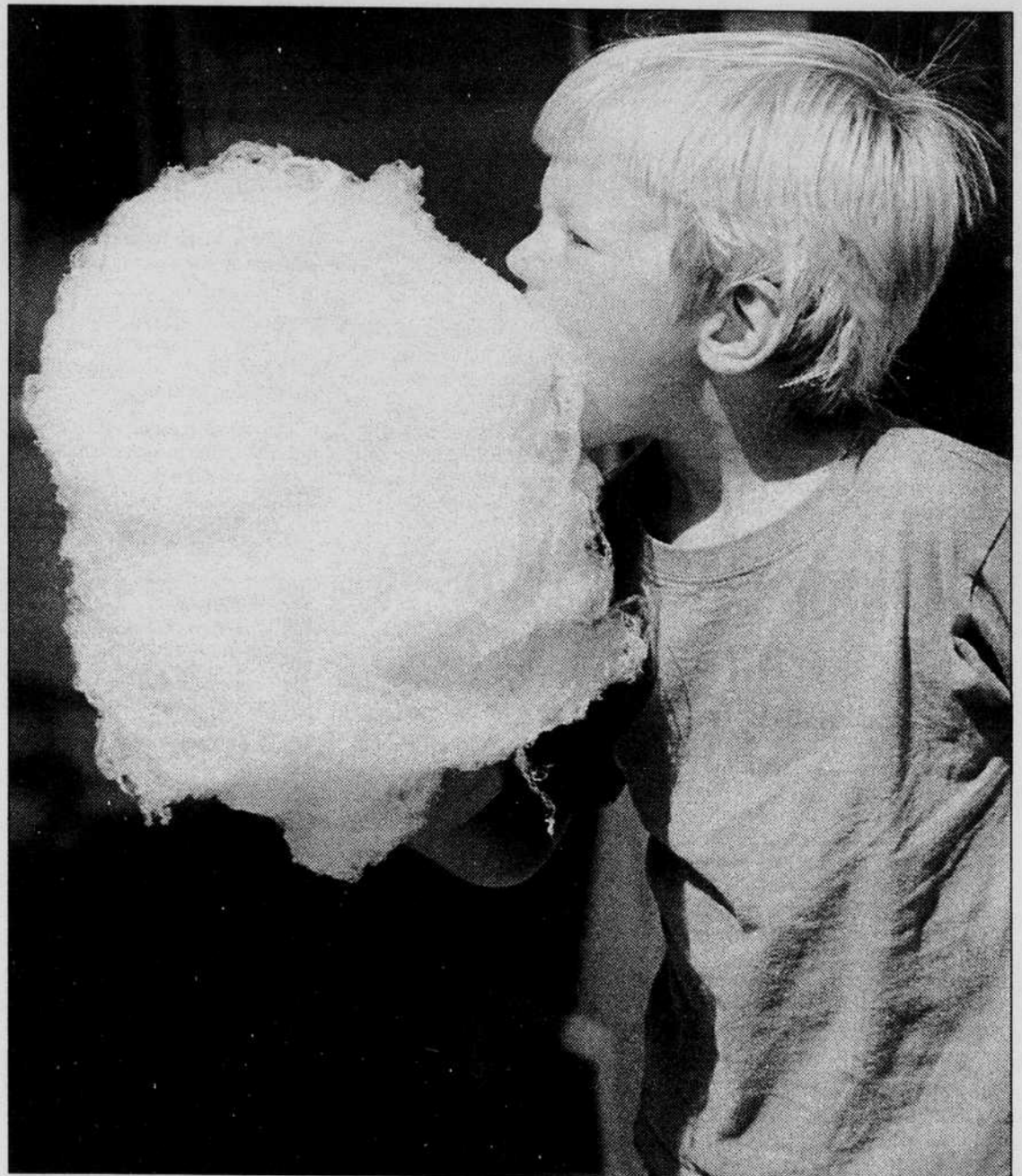

Fair offers plenty of activities

The Lane County Fair, which will be in town until August 17, reported record crowds Wednesday and expects attendance to reach 200,000 visitors by Sunday evening.

"We had a record crowd last night," said Kathee McDermott, fair spokesperson, referring to Tuesday, the day when Weird Al Yankovic performed at the Bi-Mart Main Stage.

Other locations featuring music attractions are the Music Garden and the Micro-Brew Beer Garden.

Children's entertainment can

be found at the U-Lane-O Kids Park.

Exhibits and demonstrations can be viewed in the Expo Halls, the Performance Hall, Wheeler Pavilion, Livestock Pavilion, Auditorium and the Ice Arena.

McDermott said visitors can look forward to a performance by Springfield country singer Lydia Miller on Friday and a celebration commemorating the 20 year anniversary of Elvis' death on Saturday. The celebration will feature a performance by Elvis impersonator David Lomond.

Throughout the week, the fair will feature performances by bands such as Caliente, Boogie

Chillen, Lil' Lynne & The Smokin' Soles and the Bouncing Baby Boomers.

So far, the most popular attractions have been the 20-foot rock climbing wall, two 200 pound baby tigers, a baby lion, the farm animal nursery and the children's art exhibits.

The fair opens at 11 a.m. and closes at 11 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. On Sunday, the fair opens at 11 a.m. and closes at 9 p.m.

Admission for age 18 and over is \$7; for ages 12-17, \$5; ages 6-11, \$3. Children 5 and under are free. Parking is free.
