

Pac-10: Struggling Irish in a must-win game at Stanford

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against Arizona.

The Cougars (1-3, 0-0 Conference USA) will need to try to stop Bruins quarterback Cade McNown and running back Skip Hicks if they have any hopes of an upset. McNown ranks second in the conference in total offense with 269.5 yards per game, while Hicks leads the conference in rushing yards with 121 per game and 11 rushing touchdowns.

Houston is expected to be without tailback Ketric Sanford, who is Conference USA's leading rusher. Sanford underwent an appendectomy Sept. 23.

No. 19 Stanford vs. Notre Dame

The Fighting Irish (1-3) better bring a big defensive effort to Stanford Stadium, where the Cardinal (3-1, 2-0) destroyed the Oregon

defense for 58 points in a win last week, unless it wants to begin a season 1-4 for the first time since 1985.

The Irish are in the midst of their first three-game losing streak since 1987 and have not scored any points in the third quarter of a game this season. This is the Irish's third straight game against a ranked opponent. They have lost to No. 12 Michigan State and No. 6 Michigan in their previous two games.

Stanford has received tremendous balance from its offense, with Chad Hutchinson directing a high-flying passing game and the running back tandem of Mike Mitchell and Anthony Bookman leading the way on the ground. Despite giving up 49 points to the Ducks last week, the Stanford defense held when it needed to.

Notre Dame quarterback Ron Powlus needs

117 yards passing to surpass Steve Beuerlein as the career passing leader at the school.

UNLV at Southern California

Southern California (1-2, 1-1) finally got its first victory of the season last weekend against Cal. The Trojans improved slightly on the ground vs. the Bears, but their 1.7 yards per carry and 59.7 yards per game still ranks last in the Pac-10.

Southern California should improve in that category against the Rebels (2-2, 1-1 WAC), who are still without three defensive players suspended for two games by head coach Jeff Horton. Starting defensive end Rodrick Jones, reserve linebacker Bret Gilbert and reserve defensive back Shaun Haslip were suspended prior to last weekend's victory over Illinois State for violating an unspecified team rule.

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
