Losing streak ends as Ducks tie Weber State

Oregon loses to Utah, but
ties Weber State
over the weekend to
end a five-game skid

It wasn't as good as a win, but
at least it wasn't a loss.

The Oregon women's soccer
team tied Weber State 1-1 Sun-
day to end a five-game losing
streak and move its overall
record to 3-7-1. The Ducks lost 4-
3 to Utah on Friday in the first
leg of the two-game trip.

Sunday's game remained
scoreless until Weber State's Tara
Ferrin scored with about 25 min-
utes remaining in the game, giv-
ing the Wildcats (10-2-1) a 1-0
lead.

"They scored first, and it
would have been very easy to
pull the pin, pack up and head to
the airport," Oregon head coach
Bill Steffen said, "but we didn't
give up. To the last second, we
wanted to get the ball in play and
not run the clock out."

The Ducks answered the Wild-
cats' goal with about 10 minutes
remaining on a shot from right
center by Kristi Morris.

Both teams had several
chances after that but failed to
capitalize.

"We even had one hit the un-
derside of the bar, come down on
the chalk line and then bounce
out," Steffen said.

The Ducks were outshot 35-6
by the Wildcats, and Oregon
goalkeeper Amanda Fox record-
ed a season-high 14 saves, in-
cluding five in overtime.

On Friday, the Ducks nearly
pulled off an amazing comeback
against Utah.

Trailing 4-0, they scored three
goals in the final 20 minutes to
pull within one and give the Utes
a scare.

Erin Anderson scored with
about 18 minutes remaining to
get the Ducks on the scoreboard.
Sierra Marsh followed about
eight minutes later to close the
gap to 4-2.

With less than two minutes re-
maining, Morris found the back
of the net, and the Ducks were
on the verge of
stunning Utah.

However, the
Utes kept the
ball away from
the Ducks as the
clock ticked down and held on
for the victory.

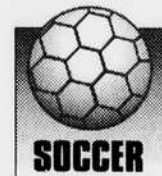
Utah jumped on Oregon early,
getting a goal from Staci Burt less
than two minutes into the game
to take a 1-0 lead. The Utes took a
2-0 lead into halftime, then re-
ceived two goals from Lorrie Tip-
ton early in the second half to
open up the 4-0 margin.

"Basically in the first half we
watched Utah play," Steffen said.
"We were very passive and we
let them play."

"In the second half we got a lit-
tle bit more involved and a little
bit more aggressive. We wanted
to try and take the game from
them and take it to them."

Tipton led the Utes with two
goals and two assists. Utah goal-
keeper Tawni Martineau record-
ed five saves while Fox led the
Ducks with nine. The Ducks
were outshot 22-11.

Oregon returns to action when
it enters Pacific-10 Conference
play Friday at Washington.



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
