Ferry St. walkway closes on west side

Cyclists and pedestrians crossing the Ferry Street Bridge must now share the east side walkway for travel in both directions due to the closing of the west side walkway. The path, which will be closed until 1998, will be removed and replaced with a wider walkway.

The west side walkway used to connect Coburg Road to Skinner Butte Park.

Now, northbound traffic must use Fourth Avenue to get

on the walkway. Southbound traffic can use either the Alton Baker Park ramp access or a bike loop underpass following Club Road.

Cyclists and pedestrians are advised to exercise caution when using the bike loop underpass because it has been modified with a narrow wooden bridge spanning a wide trench.

As added safety precautions, cyclists are advised to walk their bikes through the area. In addition, detour signs, maps and handouts are available for guidance.

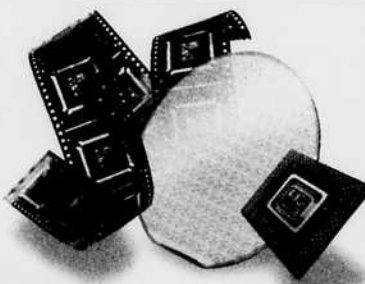
