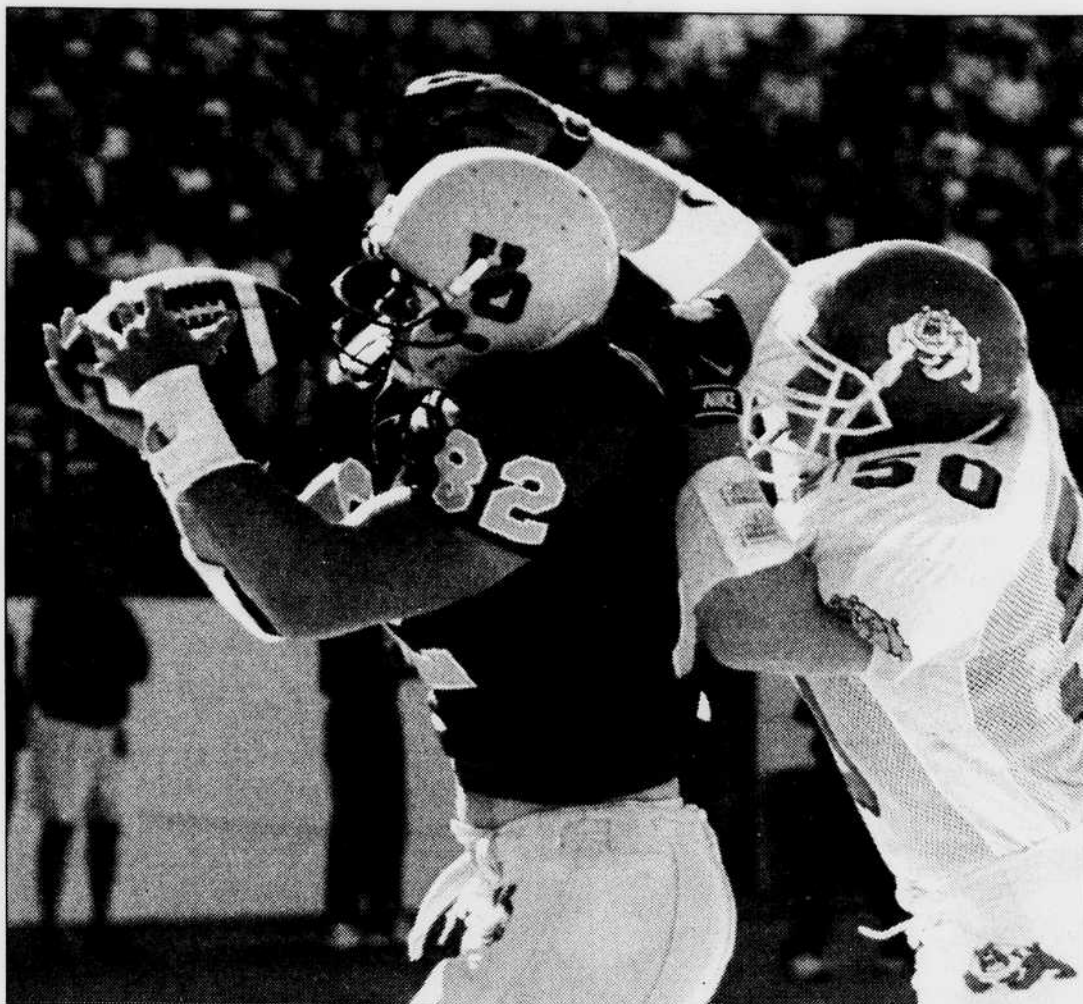

going to do, not an oversight of any particular player or position.

Against Fresno State, the plan all week was to exploit the tight ends.

"I've never been looked at that many times in game," Spence says. "I've never even dreamed of scoring that many times."

Being a good receiver and having the ability to run after the catch will get you into the game, but being a good blocker is mandatory for any tight end who plays in the Oregon system, says Osborne.

"When I find the zone with blocking, it can actually be pretty fun," Spence says. "But blockers don't get the glory. Well, the tight ends do sometimes, but not the linemen down in the trenches."

So it's about the getting the glory?

"No, no," Spence says. "I just like having the ball."

Not exactly "Just Gimme the Damn Ball," but then again, that has never been Spence's style.

"I don't really look at my stats," Spence says. "You never know when or how many times you're going to get the ball. It's out of your control, so why worry about it. I just want to play consistent and set a good example for the other guys."

Which is exactly what head coach Mike Bellotti was hoping for.

"The biggest void he had to fill wasn't on the field, but the personality that Josh Wilcox had, and he has done a great job with that," Bellotti says. "He's not a real extrovert. He was really hesitant at first but he has come to enjoy that position. I think Blake has done a great job both on the field and with his leadership."
