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the second round of the NCAA Tournament, where it lost to eventual national champion Tennessee. The first-round win on the road was the Ducks' first in team history.

Oregon lost its two leading scorers and rebounders in Arienne Boyer and Renae Fegent to graduation but should be able to replace those losses with a combination of players.

Sophomore center Jenny Mowe should replace much of the rebounding and part of the scoring. Point guard Natalie Hughes, the leading returning scorer, and shooting guard Lisa Bowyer will add additional help in the scoring department.

Tonight's game will be the Slovaks' second against a Pac-10 team this week. They lost 79-65 to the Washington Huskies on Tuesday when they shot just 34.6 percent from the field and turned the ball over 29 times.

But Oregon assistant coach Fred Litzenger said the Slovaks' late arrival in Seattle on Monday night contributed to their poor play.

Litzenger said the Slovaks play a classic international style of basketball: a physical, fast-breaking, three-point shoot-

"They are good playing one on one," Litzenger said. "Their posts can step out, catch the ball and drive. They like to fast break and get the ball up and down the floor. They're a wide-open team that does a little of everything."

Hopefully, this time around the Ducks can get a full game in against the Slovaks.

Last season, a Slovakian team walked off the court, disgusted with the officiating, with less than five minutes remaining in the game and Oregon leading 73-59.

The Slovaks' disgust with American officiating apparently hasn't changed this season. Against Washington, they were whistled for 31 fouls and three technical fouls credited to the bench for arguing with officials. Five Slovakian players fouled out.
