years old. The workshop, however, is usually held only once or twice a year and is designed primarily for adults.

The cost of the workshop is \$15 in advance and \$20 at the door. Participants should wear clothes suitable for dancing, such as harem pants with a short top, and should bring objects to balance, including baskets or small trays. Traditional dance attire, such as tights and leotards, are not usually worn in belly dancing.

"The origins of this type of belly dancing are in India, by tribal groups in the Rajastan region of Northwest [India]," Theora said. "It's a very old art form. I know that the University of Oregon has a large dance department. If someone has experience with other types of dance and wants to learn more, this is a great opportunity."

After the performance, vendors will be present to sell costumes, balancing objects, scarves and an assortment of other belly dancing items.

Theora also runs Theora's Belly Dance Boutique, which sells clothing and accessories.

## The magic of 'Dreamcoat' hits Hult

Andrew Lloyd Webber's "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" is coming to the Hult Center for the Thanksgiving holiday.

The touring production will be in Eugene throughout Thanksgiving week, and everyone will have the chance to experience a typical Broadway production. The Theater League of Eugene and Magicworks Entertainment, the producers of the show, have decided to extend the original run by three performances.

The story of "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" is biblical in origin. It is the story of Jacob and his twelve sons, his favorite being Joseph. Jacob shows his favoritism toward Joseph by giving him a coat of many colors, which makes Joseph's brothers very jealous. The brothers sell him into slavery, but he finds his way to the

wealthy Potifar, and his real powers are exposed. Joseph turns out to be a gifted individual able to interpret dreams and predict catastrophes.

Linda Sanders, publicist for the show, calls it a "kaleidoscope of song and dance."

As with many of his other successful musicals, Webber teamed up with Tim Rice to write the music and lyrics for "Joseph." This was the first musical they wrote together, with Webber as the composer and Rice as the lyricist. Rice also wrote lyrics for such Disney film soundtracks as "The Lion King" and "Aladdin."

Tickets are available at the Hult Center and through local ticket outlets. Prices for the Monday, Tuesday and Friday performances range from \$17.50 to \$35, and Wednesday performances cost between \$12.50 and \$27.50.

"Bring the entire family to see this national touring production," Sanders said.
