In 1971, Nixon had yet to become a crook, but the Beavers were just learning how to steal losses from the clutches of victory.

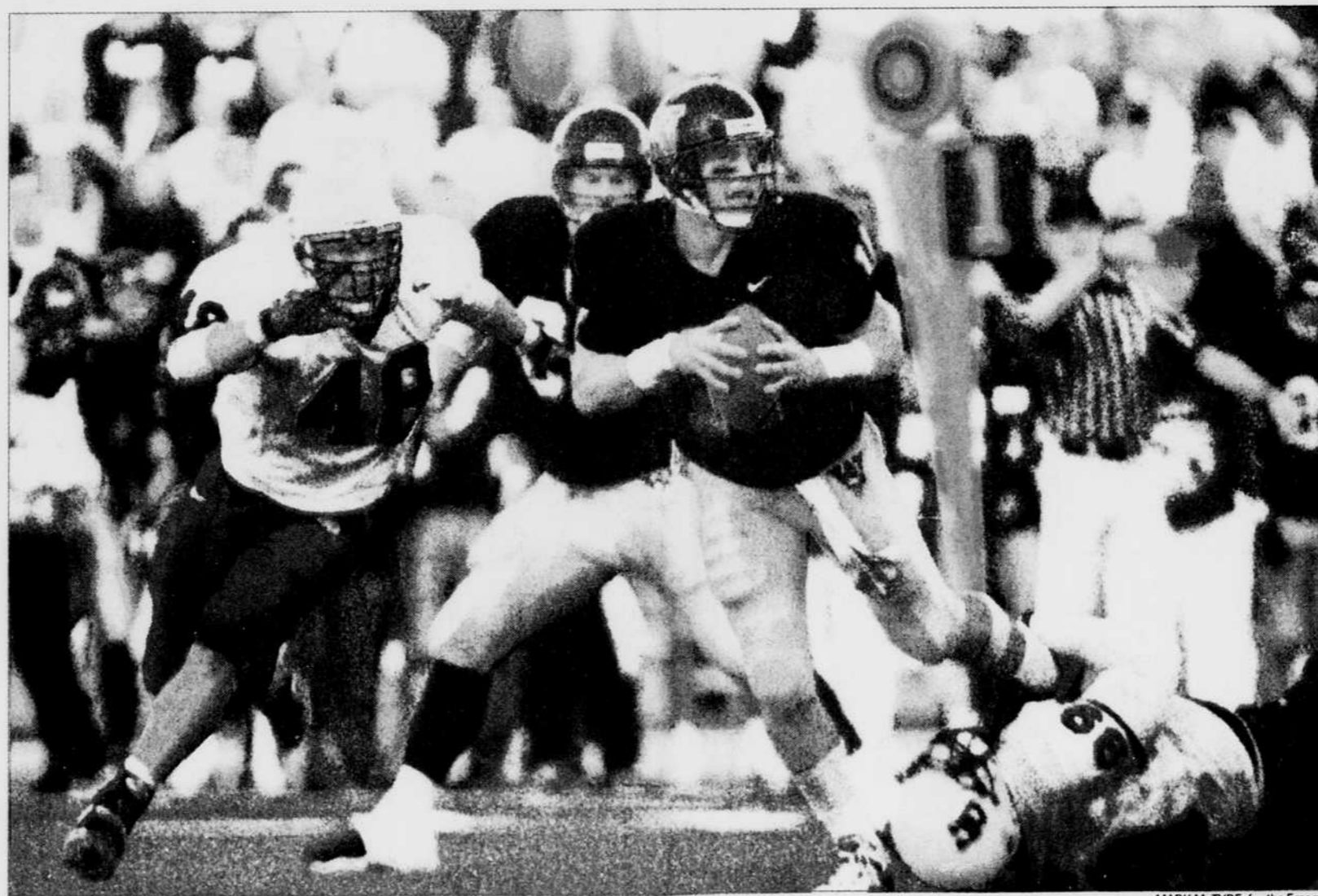


### Bell Bottoms

# Do or die time for Ducks' bowl hopes



After giving up 405 yards on the ground against Arizona State, the Oregon defense will get a rest this Saturday against the Pac-10's worst rushing offense in Oregon State

There will be two teams at Autzen Stadium on Saturday afternoon. One football team will be playing for a trip to a bowl game while also aiming for its fourth straight winning season. The other will be looking to end its season on a positive note while suffering through its 27th straight losing season.

It must be Civil War time in Oregon.

The Ducks (5-5 overall, 2-5 Pacific-10 Conference) and Oregon State (3-7, 0-7) will face off at 1 p.m. in Eugene in the 101st playing of this heated in-state rivalry.

"One of the neat things about the Civil War," said Oregon head coach Mike Bellotti, "is that there aren't too many people on the fence — they're either a Beaver or a Duck. There will be a great deal of emotion and excitement about the game within the state.

"We want to be known as the best football team in the state of Oregon, and if you win this game that is one of the ways you get that title."

Just as the case has been the last three seasons, Oregon's performance against Oregon State will reflect directly upon its postseason. The Ducks are in a must-win situation to become bowl eligible. If they accomplish this, they have a good opportunity to be invited to any one of three bowl games — the
