Thomas Autzen, key UO contributor, dies

Portland philanthropist Thomas Autzen, known for his donations and contributions to the University, died Saturday. He was 79.

Autzen made the biggest donation, \$250,000, for construction on the University football stadium in 1965.

The stadium was named after Autzen's father, who is also named Tom.

"Thomas Autzen lived a lifetime of incredibly visionary philanthropy, not only to the University," University President Dave Frohnmayer said in the Dec. 2 issue of The Oregonian.

"Even in frail health, he was a regular participant in the University of Oregon events,

especially in Portland, and he would make a special effort for big events in Eugene. ... And you could always see him here on football Saturday."

Since 1952, Autzen served as president of the Autzen Foundation, which has made contributions to the Robert D. Clark Honors College, Knight Library, the biology department, the Museum of Natural History and the Earl A. Chiles Business Center.

Autzen was also a member of the University Foundation Board of Trustees for 20 years. He served as the board's president for seven years.

Autzen was born April 12, 1918, in North Portland's St. Johns neighborhood. He graduated from the University in 1943 with degrees in political science and economics.
