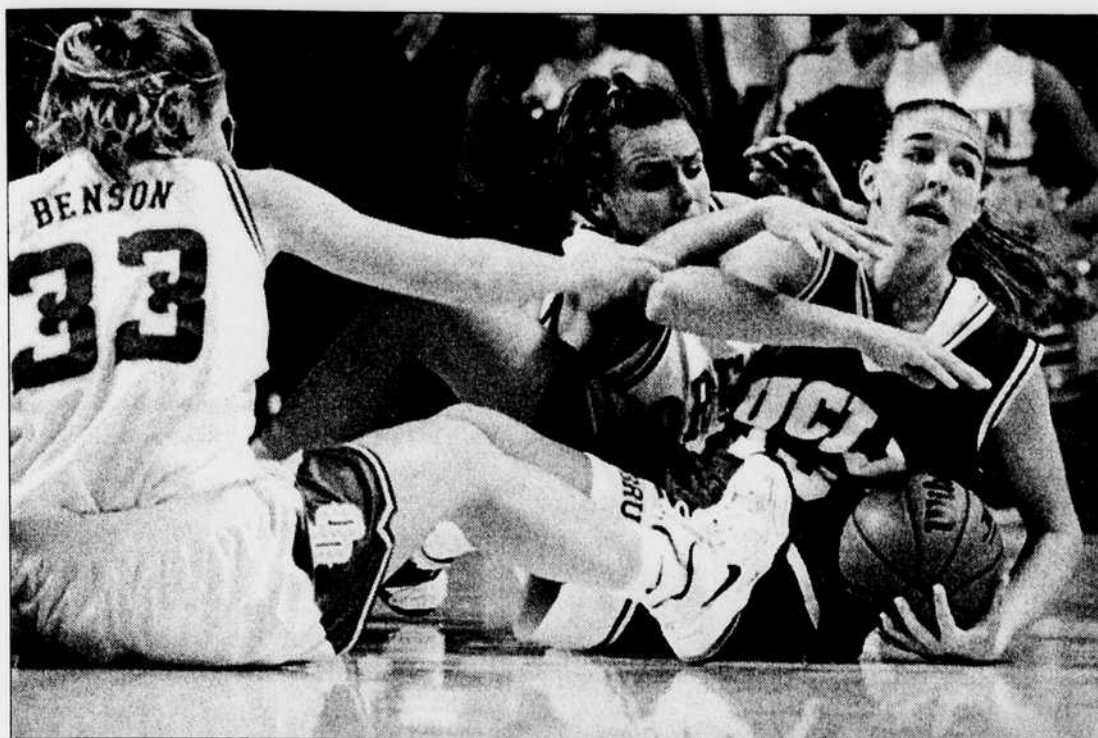

percent from the line, hitting 15 of 33 attempts for the game.

Oregon's previous worst performance from the line was a 48-percent night against Kansas.

"You have to want to be on the line," a visibly frustrated Runge said. "When you are one down and you've got two free throws, you have to want to be there. You have to want to step up there and know that, 'I'm going to put these down. I'm in control.'"

Angelina Wolvert seemed just as frustrated as Runge.

"I'm upset. It's stupid to lose games for something that's such a personal part of the game," she said.

Brianne Meharry missed six of her 13 attempts from the line, but still tied Wolvert for a team high of 15 points. Wolvert missed the only shot she took in the first half, but finished the game seven for nine from the field.

Natalie Hughes scored 11 points and Lisa Bowyer, returning to the lineup after an ankle injury kept her out of Thursday's game, and Sonja Curtis had 10.

While the free throws were an obvious problem for Oregon, so was UCLA's Maylana Martin.

The 6-foot-3 sophomore, who was last season's Pac-10 freshman of the year, tallied 27 points

"The difference in the game is that we didn't make free throws. I think that's been the difference in every game we haven't won, and we need to get that squared away. I'm not sure how that's going to happen except for this team taking personal responsibility to make sure that they do that."

on a 10-for-17 performance from the field, grabbed 12 rebounds and hit seven for 10 attempts from the free-throw line.

"Maylana Martin comes up with some big baskets down the stretch," UCLA head coach Kathy Olivier said.

Martin scored 10 of the Bruins' final 16 points to help the Bruins pull away from Oregon after the tie at 62.

Early in the game neither team was able to break away from the other as the two teams traded the lead eight times in the first half.

After falling behind by four with just over six minutes to play in the half, the Ducks rallied to take a two-point lead two and half minutes later.

But with 2:31 to play in the opening half, Oregon would take its last lead of the game, 33-32, as the Bruins finished the half on an 11-0 run to take a 10-point lead into the locker room.

Janae Hubbard, UCLA's 6-4 sophomore center, scored six straight points during that 11-0 run and finished with 12 points, all coming in the first half.

Bruin point guard Erica Gomez played the entire game, tallying 10 points, five rebounds, five assists and three steals.

"It's not like we're relying on just one person," said Olivier, the Bruins' fifth-year head coach. "Erica Gomez played 40 minutes, and I thought May came up with some big points down the stretch. Janae Hubbard started the game off very aggressively. Every night is a different person for us."

Knowing that two losses this early in the conference season could mean trouble for Oregon's NCAA Tournament hopes, Bowyer understood the importance of Saturday's loss.

"We need to win all home games," Bowyer said. "If we had done the little things, we would have gone away with a win."

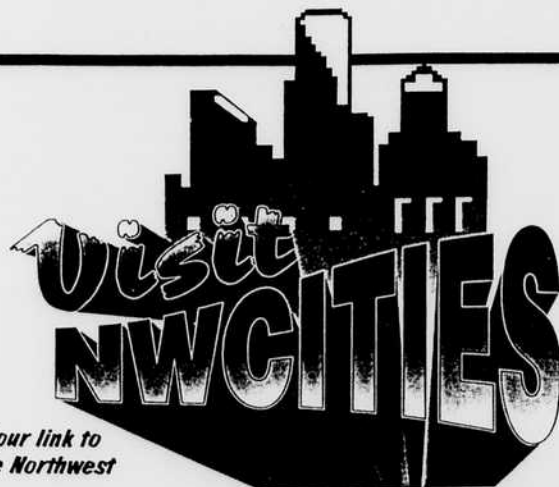
