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UO: Ducks forfeit 126-pound class

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(12-0) a commanding 18-15 lead with only two matches remaining.

"I think we gave a pretty good effort," head coach Ron Finley said. "But we made a lot of mistakes and that's something you can't do against a solid team like Lock Haven."

The Ducks' mistakes didn't come early.

Oregon (4-1 overall, 3-0 in Pacific-10 Conference) earned two major decisions in its first three matches to surge past Lock Haven in the early going. John Taylor, who has missed the majority of the Ducks' matches this season with injuries, earned an impressive 18-7 victory over Lock Haven's Mike Wehler in the 118-pound opening match.

But the momentum and large Oregon lead was rendered mute when the Ducks failed to qualify a wrestler in the 126-pound class and were forced to forfeit the match minutes later. The forfeit gave Lock Haven a 6-4 advantage after two matches. "The forfeit really put us into an early hole," Finley said. "We can't afford to give away points like that in big meets."

The Ducks took back the lead when 134-pound Jeremy Ensrud earned a 14-3 major decision over Terry Showalter. Showalter, ranked fourth in the country at 126 pounds, moved up to face Ensrud after the Ducks forfeited his match.

"The match went about the way we thought it would," En-

srud said, "but obviously we're disappointed with the results. I thought we wrestled hard as a team, but just fell a bit short."

Despite Mark Castle's 7-2 loss in the 142-pound match, Oregon seemed to keep momentum throughout the meet. Daryl Christian widened the Ducks' lead with an 11-3 win over Dan Cowfer in the 150-pound match, and 167-pound Kevin Keeney broke a 12-12 tie late with a bruising 8-2 victory against Ben Stehura.

"Both wrestlers did a real solid job and seemed to dominate their opponents," Finley said.

But Oregon was never able to put Lock Haven away.

Sean Morgan lost a bitter two-overtime match to Neil Barnes that marked the beginning of the end for the Ducks. Barnes, the nation's 12th-ranked wrestler at 158 pounds, trailed 4-3 in the final seconds of the match when the referee called Morgan for stalling and awarded the Lock Haven senior one point to tie the score. The call upset the majority of the 552 in attendance and drew the Bald Eagles even at 12.

Following Murray's pin that gave them the lead, Lock Haven's Kenny Hines overcame a 2-1 second-period deficit to beat 190-pound Chael Sonnen in a furious third-period rally. Hines scored a two-point take down early in the period and cruised to an 8-4 victory.

"I thought that Chael wrestled smart but was a little more aggressive than he needed to be at that time," Finley said. "But he wrestled a tough opponent. Lock Haven just seemed to make the adjustments that we didn't."

Heavyweight Rich Polkinghorn upped his record this season to 12-6 with a 3-0 win over Bill Bell in the final match, but Lock Haven had all but wrapped up the victory in the previous two matches.

"We wrestled hard but need to be more focused," Polkinghorn said. "We need to wrestle smart."



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
