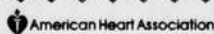
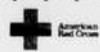

ry director David Etherington said. "So it doesn't require a vast array of super computers."

Because the program can operate on a personal computer, Etherington said it can filter out into the world and benefit small businesses.

According to Ginsberg, one of the main benefits of artificial intelligence is the speed at which machines can solve problems.

"If you have a problem with a zillion possibilities to solve it, a computer can search through all of the possible solutions and select the best one," Ginsberg said.
