Oregon moves up in national poll

*The No. 21 Ducks will
face Civil War rival
No. 19 Oregon State*

The Oregon wrestling team's stellar tournament finishes and 4-1 start to the season have finally caught the eyes of coaches around the country. The Ducks moved up nine spots in the National Wrestling Coaches Association Wrestling Poll this week to No. 21 in the country. The move came despite a 21-18 loss to No. 15 Lock Haven at McArthur Court on Saturday.

Oregon, who took first place at the Great Plains Invitational in Lincoln, Neb., on Jan. 4, and third-place at the Midlands Tournament in Evanston, Ill., the week prior, is one of three Pacific-10 Conference teams now ranked in the top 25.

Friday will be Oregon's first

Civil War test this season against No. 19 Oregon State. The Beavers upped their record to 6-4 this season with a 29-18 win over No.

22 Rider last weekend at the Virginia Duals. Prior to its sixth win, Oregon State lost 25-10 to No. 1 Oklahoma State and forced a tie out of No. 16 Cornell.

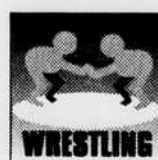
After only five dual meets and four tournaments, three Oregon wrestlers have already eclipsed the 20-win mark, with several more closing in. Jeremy Ensrud (20-1), Daryl Christian (20-6) and Sean Morgan (20-7) are tied for the team lead in wins. Chael Sonnen (18-6) and Kevin Keeney (16-4) are close approaching the 20-win plateau. The Ducks featured only four 20-match winners all of last season.

Ensrud is one win away from

tying Curt Strahm for seventh place on the Ducks' career-win list with 93 victories. The 134-pound senior has eight more dual meets this season and the Pac-10 and NCAA Championships remaining to eclipse Strahm's total.

Head coach Ron Finley, an Oregon State alumni, has not had the success over the Beavers that he has had with other Pac-10 teams in his 28 seasons at Oregon. The Ducks are 15-38-2 against their state rival under Finley. Oregon State lead the overall series record at 67-19-2, but the Ducks have compiled nine of their 19 total wins in the last 10 years. Oregon State holds a slim 12-9-2 advantage over Oregon since 1987. Oregon won both meets against the Beavers last season.

Friday's Civil War battle in Corvallis will be broadcast on Fox Sports Northwest on Saturday at 11 a.m.

Meharry is averaging 14.4 points and 6.5 rebounds per contest. Her numbers put her 10th in the conference in scoring, seventh in field-goal percentage (55.5) and tied for 10th in rebounds.

In conference play, Meharry and fellow freshman Angelina Wolverter have combined to average 28.3

points per game and shot a combined 56.2 percent from the field.

gon's Terik Brown will face younger brother Bryan Brown, who is a walk-on guard for the Huskies.

Terik, a junior, is second on the Ducks in scoring, averaging 10.2 points per game while starting in 12 of 13 games.

Bryan has played in eight games for Washington, averaging under five minutes per game.

And just like his older brother, Bryan has a propensity to shoot the three pointer.

The freshman has taken only eight shots this season — seven of those shots were from beyond

the arc.

Odds and ends

Oregon is fourth in the Pac-10 in free throw percentage at .703 and second in the league in rebounding defense at 31.3.

The team is also fourth in the league in three-point field goals made per game at 6.1.

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
