

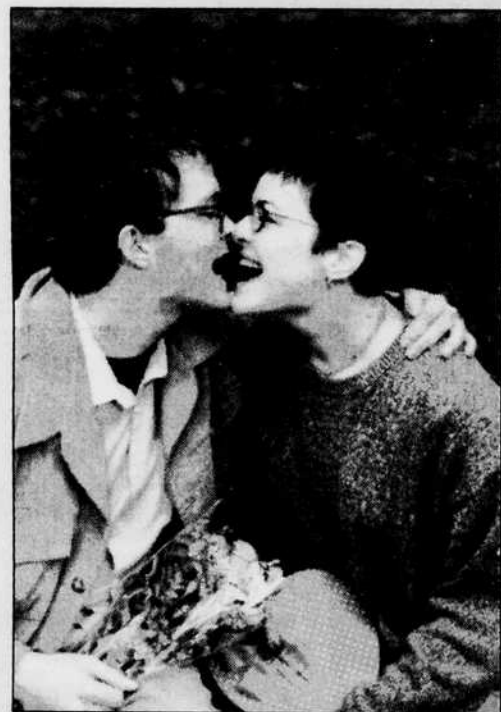

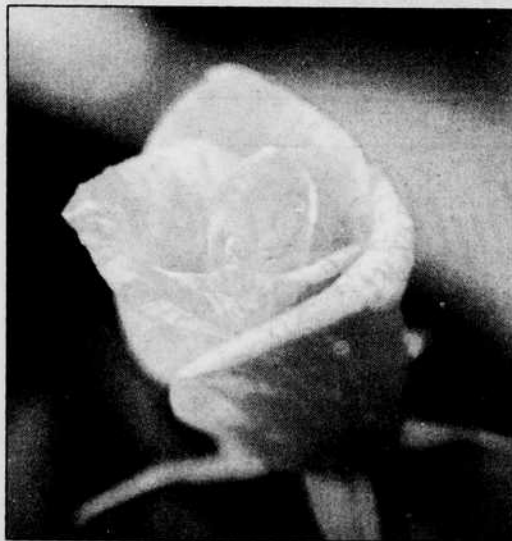
Matthew and Sara share a chocolate from the heart-shaped box. Later, they ate all the candy.

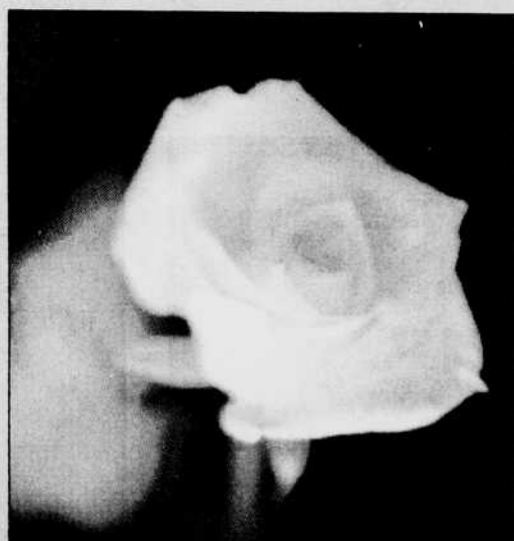
This photo was difficult to set up because many of the chocolates had already been eaten.

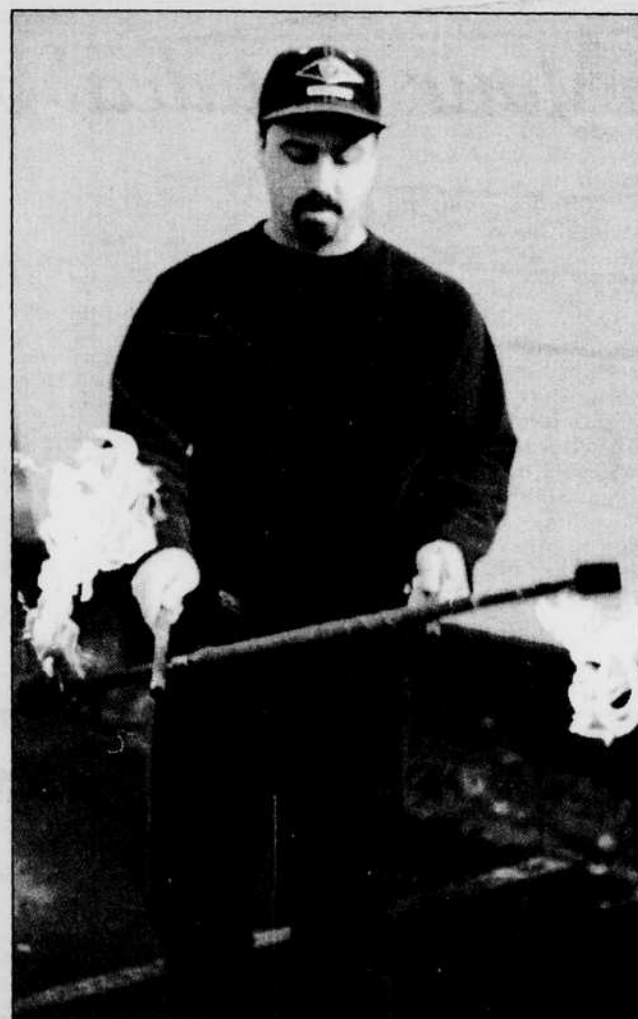
This is a classic white rose. Roses are most expensive now because they are out of season.
