Kitzhaber to meet with students in EMU

Gov. John Kitzhaber will meet with the Oregon Student Association's Board of Directors and ASUO President Bill Miner to discuss student concerns from 2 to 2:30 p.m. today in the EMU Ben Linder Room.

Miner said the list of topics includes student control over fees, as well as asking Kitzhaber to veto any bills coming out of the state Senate or House that would restrict student control.

Other topics include the quality of higher education, an increase in faculty compensation, funding campus childcare and increasing funding for the Oregon Need Grant.

Following the meeting, Kitzhaber will conduct an open session for student questions, which may include all the

above topics and his candidacy for governor.
