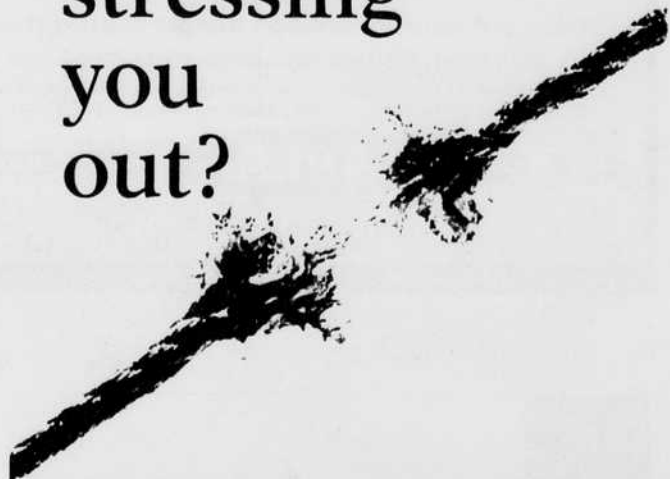

Farlane uses comic-book drawings, advertisements and action-hero figures made from spare parts "found in K.B. Toy Store's sale bin" to share personal narratives, fears and stories from his own life.

"In one part of this it describes the whole [MFA] process I had to go through and all the feelings that go into it," McFarlane said.

The MFA graduating process will end for 18 graduate students at the opening reception of "Completion," an exhibition of their final projects on Friday, May 8 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the University's Museum of Art.

"The students involved in this project have been working the last two weeks and even months in advance for the exhibition," said Heather Brown, public relations coordinator for the museum. "This is the last project they need to do to graduate."

The annual debut exhibition is sponsored by the Ballinger family in memory of late fine arts student Court Ballinger.

Brown said the exhibition features painting, printmaking, photography, ceramics, fibers, visual design and sculpture pieces.

"The exhibit has a life of its

own," she said. "There are paintings and things, but it's all very sculptural — it's very three-dimensional. It has a lot of motion."

At the opening reception, visitors are asked to donate art supplies for the Eugene public schools' summer programs to help children discover art.

"[Giving art supplies] gets the process of creativity going," Brown said. "It will show students the joy of creativity."

The graduate students involved in the exhibit are at the end of the education part of the creative process but are just at the beginning of another. McFarlane said he plans to use parts of his presentation for self-promotion in the job market, although they will be hard to part with.

"I'll probably send one of my figures to a proposed job opportunity," he said, "but I think most of it will end up taking space at home."

The exhibit will continue through June 14. Museum hours are noon to 8 p.m. Wednesday and noon to 5 p.m. Thursday through Sunday. Admission is free with current identification for all students, faculty, staff and museum members and \$3 for the general public.
