### No evidence Belle bet on baseball games

CHICAGO (AP) — An investigation into the gambling habits of Chicago White Sox slugger Albert Belle found no evidence he bet on baseball.

Kevin Hallinan, baseball's executive director of security and

management, spent about 14 months investigating Belle, who has admitted betting on other sports.

Players' Association lawyer Gene Orza said he had not seen a copy of the report but had been told of its findings.

"It is consistent with what we

always believed: that Albert Belle had no involvement in gambling on baseball," Orza said.

The investigation began after Belle admitted in a deposition for a lawsuit that he lost \$40,000 gambling on pro and college football and basketball games. He denied betting on baseball, which would have led to a lifetime ban.

Thirty of the Ducks' 38 victories this season have come out of conference, including six wins against teams that were ranked in the top 25 when they met. However, most of the other victories came against questionable West Coast schools that may or may not be ignored by the selection committee.
