Retired U.S. general to visit seminar

Retired U.S. Air Force General Merrill A. McPeak will be speaking to a freshman seminar on the history of aviation on Thursday, May 14.

The former member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff will speak on the importance of a strong air force as a deterrent to war, said associate Professor Emeri-

tus William E. Lamon, the instructor of the freshman seminar. The general retired from the Air Force in 1994.

"I'm amazed he agreed to come speak," Lamon said.

The speech will be open to the entire University community because of support from the Department of Military Science. McPeak will speak at 2 p.m. in 238 Gilbert.
