Ducks: Four selected to all-tournament team

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of the fourth to take a 5-4 lead, Oregon countered with its second straight three-run inning. Dumas and Robinson singled to bring home two runs and a Nebraska error at shortstop contributed to another.

Down 7-5, the Cornhuskers' bats went to work. Nebraska scored four runs over the next two innings to take back the lead and secure its first trip to the Women's College World Series since 1988.

"We knew it was going to be a slugfest," Oregon head coach Rick Gamez said in a press conference following the game. "We knew it was just a matter of being disciplined and taking advantage of the pitches in the zone. We were able to do that today."

Despite allowing 11 hits and seven Oregon runs in four innings, Voss improved her record to 39-7, the highest win total in the NCAA this season. Oregon pitcher Jennie Cook, who allowed nine runs on 15 hits in seven full innings, dropped to 21-19 this season.

But what head coach Rick Gamez will remember will be the positives.

"We have been able to produce runs against many of the top teams this season," Gamez said. "We rank right up there with the best."

There were many positives on this trip for the Ducks. There was Oregon's 11-3 victory against Coastal Carolina on Saturday morning to set up the evening rematch with Iowa. There were the Ducks' 30 combined runs in four games — the most of any team in the region. And of course there was Welch's grand slam, which gave Oregon its best postseason finish since 1989.

"We are an offensive team," Welch said following the Nebraska loss. "Leave it to the Ducks to open it up."

For their efforts, four Oregon players were selected to the region's all-tournament team: first baseman Jennifer Apfelbaum, who went 3 for 4 with a home run and two RBIs in the game against Coastal Carolina; third baseman Katie Mackey, who also had a home run and a double against the Chanticleers; and Custer and Welch, who combined for 14 RBIs in the four games.

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
