the Foo Fighters just may be foreshadowing some cinematic romance between FBI Agents Fox Mulder and Dana Scully.

A surprising addition to the album is "One More Murder," by Better Than Ezra. The song is a far cry from the band's 1995 and 1996 hits "Good" and "King of New Orleans." This creative song serves as the album's anchor with its sound and lyrics.

The album's low point comes from the established British star Sting. "Invisible Sun" by Sting and Aswad is unfortunately void of anything interesting. The song is tired and bored, like most of Sting's recent musical products. The only other low point on the album is a cover of the Doors' "Crystal Ship," by X. The song is a carbon copy, adding nothing to the original.

"The X-Files" soundtrack still stands above most soundtracks with additional solid songs from Björk, Soul Coughing, Noel Gallagher, The Cardigans, Ween, Tonic and a remix of Sarah McLachlan's "Black" from her "Solace" album.

Most soundtracks seem to be thrown together haphazardly. This one shows the movie's producers put some effort into the album and produced a great collection of songs.

For those die-hard "The X-Files" fans, the soundtrack adds a mysterious surprise several minutes after the last track. The truth is in there.
