In no particular order, here is a top ten list of somewhat-local, kinda-close getaways.

Portland

"Everything's coming up roses..." This major city is not just limited to shopping and the occasional concert. At the International Rose Test Gardens you can stop and smell more than 500 varieties of roses in Washington Park. Enjoy an evening watching the local athletic events at the Rose Garden. The Tom McCall Waterfront Park, once a freeway, is now a two-mile greenway that provides a pleasant venue for just about anything.

Willamette Pass

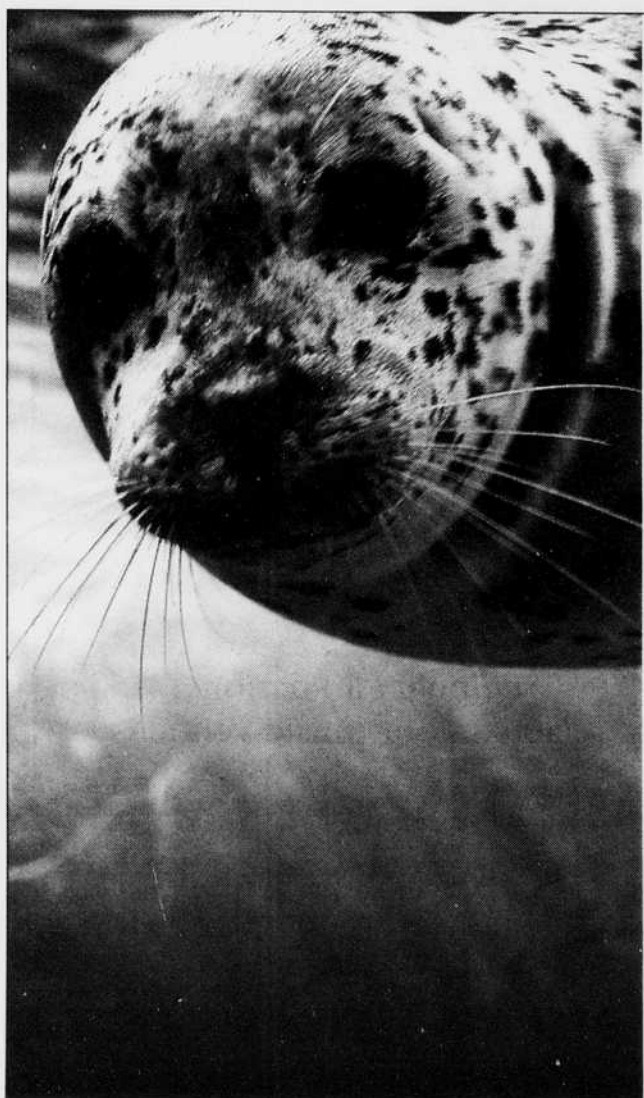
