Perhaps a source for the plot similarities is the fact that Sandler and screenwriter Tim Herlihy ("Billy Madison" and "The Wedding Singer") co-wrote this picture.

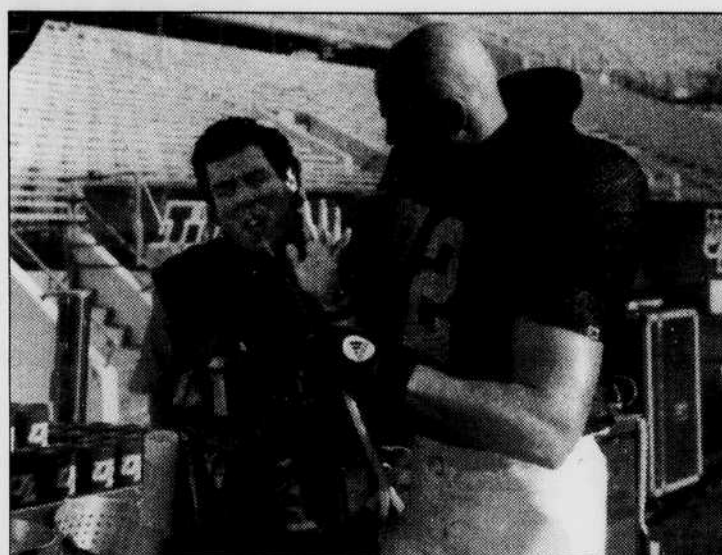
Don't get me wrong; these two have obvious chemistry when it comes to bringing humor to the big screen. But their writing seems duplicated in this production.

The Herlihy/Sandler chemistry does work, however, in "The Waterboy" in its use of interspersed and random sequences. If you remember "Billy Madison's" penguin and the hilarious dream sequences from "Gilmore," you'll laugh at the alcoholic cheerleading squad and bizarre character lines in this film. In fact, many of the cajun characters in "The Waterboy" are so ridiculous, you can't help but chuckle at the mere sight of them.

Football fans should look for cameos by plenty of gridiron faces, as well as appreciate the brutal hits Sandler's character lays on the opposing team.

Although this film fizzles due to its close linkage to an already done plot, Sandler sparkles as the leader of ne'r-do-well football batch from the bayou.

If you're looking to laugh a little, I recommend you see this film. Besides, it's an Adam Sandler comedy, and it's not meant to be taken too seriously.

"It's silly. It's irreverent," said undergraduate assistant director Matt Berliner. "It's not a thinking play. People do it with bigger smiles, whiter teeth, and more colors than you would ever see in everyday life."

The color and music create an especially inviting atmosphere for the audience, Berliner said.

"In a show like this, they don't just play to the audience, they play with the audience," he said.

The neon colors of the show jump out.

"They're silly gangsters," said Prof. Alexandra Bonds, costume designer. "I didn't want to do the hackneyed view of gangsters in striped suits. We

thought of Dick Tracy and Spiderman."

The simpler set uses scaffolding with wheels to portray the skeletal New York streets.

"It's brassy, 1950s, New York, Manhattan—a more innocent time," said Theater Arts Prof. Jerry Williams, who designed the set. "And Day-Glo was invented."

"The concept was to make it happen quickly," he said. "The Physical Plant was really swell and loaned us all the scaffolding."

Tickets are available from noon until 6 p.m. at the Robinson box office. Student prices are \$5.50; senior citizens, University faculty and staff, and non-University students are \$10; tickets are \$12 for general public.
