understand," she said, "that's OK too. It's more important to generate a dialogue."

"If [the exhibit] didn't have that simple controversy, it could be a real easy hit," Powell said. "Controversy forces the audience to debate the notion of hope."

Numerous themes exist within the exhibit, such as science, nature, the arts, life, and even death. But though there are many abstract ideas

present, many of the photos illustrate common occurrences.

"For the most part these are events most people who see the exhibit will have experienced themselves," said Larry Fong, associate director of the museum. "It's very hard not to find this very attractive, very accessible and touch a past emotion of sentiment that we have shared."
