and the cost of living, students have to pay these increases — the last thing they need to worry more about, said James Britt, the director of ASUO Student Advocacy.

"With the cost of higher education going up, it becomes less accessible to students," he said. "[The University] should consider looking at alternative revenue services, like the Oregon Campaign. I don't think folks can be successful at school when looking at where next month's rent has to come from. They shouldn't have to worry about these little surcharges."

While most of the fees may increase, there are a few that may decrease or be deleted. Banner fees that are being deleted include biology field trip fees and literature film fees from the English department.

Non-banner fees that have been deleted from the list include fees that are now included in the matriculation fee. These fees include transcript request fees, add/drop fees and application for graduation fees.

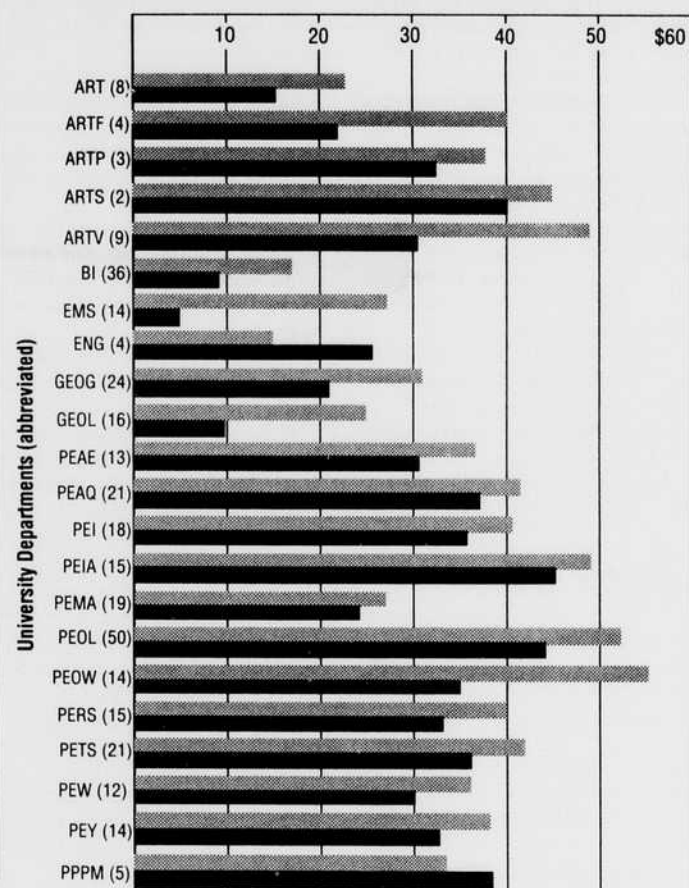
The fee change requests are under inspection by University vice presidents and will be reviewed at the open hearing in March. Rawson said she remembers some of the general public coming to the open hearing last year to discuss parking fee increases, but doesn't expect the same turnout this year.

Britt said the turnout will be low because people are tired of hearing about fees increasing.

"There are so many fees increasing in such a short amount of time that everyone is getting numb from it," he said. "They're just going to say, 'here we go again.' So I don't think very many people will show up."
