swers to life's problems through Christ."

The Alpha Omega House and its 23 men will hold a "prayer and praise" night every other Sunday beginning April 11. They also plan a "root beer kegger" during spring term.

House manager Jason Spies said the house's mission is to, "grow men in the knowledge of Jesus Christ." He said it helped him grow from an insecure Christian youth to a secure Christian man by allowing him to associate with spiritual men.

The Baptist Student Union, located at the corner of 25th Avenue and Harris Street, offers weekly meetings. These meetings are a combination of Bible study, workshops, food, singing and visiting, said Director James Sander. They will also have Bible study classes in the EMU. Sanders aims to help many students find spirituality.

"It's a very vital need that people have," he said. "Many people

fill it in nonspiritual ways."

Jewish students and those curious about Judaism can visit Hillel on Hilyard Street, said Rabbi Karen Landy. Hillel celebrates all the Jewish holidays and offers Friday night services. It also perform social actions programs in the community, presents film series and sponsors lectures.

In honor of Passover, Hillel will hold a Seder service and meal on Wednesday at 7p.m. Landy expects 150-200 students to attend. She said she has found students, "Thoughtful about what it is to be a Jew."

Baha'i Foundation offers students a belief system based on the universal acceptance of all faiths as being sent from God and expresses the oneness of all the universe, said Ted Taylor, a member of the local spiritual assembly. This faith does not have priests. The foundation has meetings on the first and third Mondays discussing and explaining their faith, Taylor said.
