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Runge, Ducks find needed assistance

After coaching high school boys' teams in Washington for 16 years, Dan Muscatell became Oregon's new recruiting coordinator and assistant women's basketball coach Wednesday, replacing Stephanie Osburn Norman, whose contract was not renewed after last season.

"Dan is a very hard worker and excited about this opportunity," head coach Jody Runge said in a released statement. "I'm confident he'll do a great job for us."

"He has a lot of contacts around the country, and he is from this region, which is where we recruit the most. I feel he will be a great salesman for this program."

Muscatell, 39, has never recruited at the college level.

"Does the fact that I don't have that experience bother me?" Muscatell said. "Not a great deal. Every job is about going out and being a good person first."

Besides contacts he made while coaching, Muscatell's other Northwest connections stem from his efforts to market a laptop computer statistics-keeping device that he developed.

A long-time friend of Oregon assistant coach Fred Litzzenberger, Muscatell has coached at Duck summer basketball camps.

"I'd like to say I know Litz as well as any male walking the face of the earth," Muscatell said. "Our coaching philosophy is the same, and that will be an important tie for our kids."

The Ducks have three scholarships to fill, and Muscatell said he is eager to join the rest of the Oregon coaching staff, which has been on the road recruiting since July 8.

He's already planned what to tell potential recruits, he said.

"Nobody other than UCLA can talk about being a Pacific-10 Conference champ last year," Muscatell said. "Not those people from down there in the Bay or anyone. That's a pretty cool thing to be able to present."



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
