Senator quits after heated meeting

Autumn Depoe quits the Student Senate after a debate over two topics

Lasting a whopping 4.5 hours, Wednesday night's Student Senate meeting ended with a senator quitting, the body's leadership being named and groups getting about \$3,500 in surplus fees.

Even more could have happened, but the EMU staff asked the group to leave so they could close for the evening.

Student Senator Autumn Depoe left during the meeting after being in heated debate about two topics. Depoe, who later said she was going to quit anyway because she is changing her major, added that the current ethics of the Student Senate make her want to "puke, wretch and hurl." Depoe's resignation letter was read at the meeting by ASUO Vice President Mitra Anoushiravani.

The first issue that Depoe voiced her concern about was regarding giving the Athletic Department Finance Committee \$1,000 to advertise how students go about getting their tickets to athletic events. It was proposed by ADFC Senator Spencer Hamlin.

Hamlin said that \$40,000 of student's tickets were sold to the general public at the USC game on Sept. 25, because they were not picked up in time by students. Hamlin, along with fellow ADFC Senator Jamila Singleton, voiced his concern that some students might not understand that tickets not picked up by students are sold to the general public five days before the event.

But Depoe disagreed, saying that the ADFC needed to "fess up" by saying that students were getting too many unneeded tickets. "It is not our job to create a demand for tickets," Depoe said.

She also added that she felt ADFC Senators were being "lazy" by wanting to place ads instead of more of a cost effective technique, such as informational sandwich boards.

The matter was settled when the senate voted against financing the campaign.

Hamlin later said he was "embarrassed" to be a part of a senate where he had to sit in the meeting while other senators "made personal attacks."

The next issue that Depoe debated on was the senate's funding of EConference 2000, an environmental conference in Philadelphia, which 21 students will be attending. Depoe sparred with Senator Jerome Grzybowski, saying that he "tried to encourage voting on [the financing of the trip] because he would be" going to the event. Grzybowski, who will be going to the conference, apologized, saying that he was not trying to do that.

The measure was approved, which will give \$3139 of student fees to cover airfare of the attendees. \$500 of the money was a loan that must be repaid to the senate by June of 2000.

In matters of great importance as well, Jessica Timpany was elected as the Student Senate president for this year. Spencer Hamlin was elected Vice President; Eric Pfeiffer was elected Ombudsman; and Jamila Singleton was elected to the Associated Students Presidential Advisory Committee, respectively.



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
