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n The fourth question he asked the committee was how more general labor issues such as acceptable workplace standards and living wages factor into the code.

Frohnmayr emphasized that these are starting points for the committee's discussion. He encouraged them to expand their discussion to include other areas that he may not have mentioned, yet he hoped the committee would move rapidly to make its recommendations.

While the committee is not required to have its meetings open to the public under the Oregon Public Meetings Law, it has chosen to do so. The committee will welcome observers at future meetings, however it reserves the right to close the meeting to the public.

The committee plans to discuss the issue of full disclosure of factory locations and make its first recommendation to Frohnmayr at its next meeting.

"I know it's very much on Dave's mind to move as quickly as possible on the disclosure issue," said Duncan McDonald, vice-president of public affairs and development, and facilitator of the committee.

Funds allocated to Oregon Dance, Conflict Resolution

Squeezing in a quick meeting before Thanksgiving, the Student Senate met Tuesday night and approved special requests for Conflict Resolution Services and Oregon Dance.

Conflict Resolution Services was given \$791 to help cover the registration fee for a conference in Chapel Hill, N.C., Program Director Annie Betz said the conference will deal with professional training for the program's employees.

Conflict Resolution, which is

directly funded 60 percent by the student fee and 40 percent by the Office of Student Life, requested the money after being denied the money from Student Life because of a lack of funds, according to the request presented by Betz.

The Student Senate gave Oregon Dance \$420 to send four members to The American College Dance Festival. The group, which is sending 10 students to the spring event, will finance the other six students' registration by fund raising.
